- (vi) Upazila Co-operative Officer, ex-officio;
- (vii) Upazila Livestock Officer, ex-officio;
- (viii) Upazila Fishery Officer, ex-officio;
  - (ix) Upazila Social Welfare Officer, ex-officio;
  - (x) Upazila Rural Development Officer, ex-officio;
  - (xi) Upazila Mass Communication Officer, ex-officio;
- (xii) Upazila Revenue Officer, ex-officio; and
- (xiii) Officer-in-charge, Police Station, ex-officio.
- (e) Chairman of the Thana Central Co-operative Association within the Upazila; and
  - (f) One member (to be nominated by the Government).
- (2) Until the Chairman is elected and enters upon his office, the Upazila Nirbahi Officer shall act as Chairman of the Upazila Parishad.
