No. S. R. O. 19-L/75/1/75-Excise.—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 37 of the Excises and Salt Act, 1944 (1 of 1944) the National Board of Revenue is pleased to make the following amendments in the Central Excise Rules, 1944, namely,—

In the said Rules,—

(a) in rule 2, in clause (v), *after* the words and figure “under section 3”, the words, figure and letter “or section 3A” shall be *inserted*; and

(b) *after* rule 3, the following new rule (3A) shall be *inserted*, namely,—

“3A. Duty to be incorporated in the price of excisable goods and services.—Duty shall be incorporated in the price of all excisable goods and excisable services and not shown separately in any document relating to the sale of any such goods or services.”

No. S.R.O. 20-L/75/Cus 203.—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 19 of the Customs Act, 1969 (IV of 1969), the Government is pleased to exempt all equipments and supplies donated by the United Nations Children's Emergency Fund and imported into Bangladesh for use in family planning, health, rural water supply, education or other welfare projects or programmes executed by the Government with the aid of the United Nations Children's Emergency Fund from the payment of the whole of the customs-duties subject to the conditions that the Ministry concerned shall furnish to the Collector of Customs at the time of clearance of such goods a certificate to the effect that the goods have been imported with the prior approval of the Government and that the goods shall not be sold, transferred or otherwise disposed of without the prior permission of the National Board of Revenue and without payment of the customs-duties due thereon.

2. This notification shall be deemed to have come into effect from 16th December 1971.

## MINISTRY OF INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING

No. S.R. O 21-L/75/1(26)/73-M.P.(Prt. IV).—In exercise of the power conferred by section 20 of the Newspaper Employees (Conditions of Service) Act, 1974 (Act No. XXX of 1974), the Government is pleased to make the following rules:

### THE NEWSPAPER EMPLOYEES (CONDITIONS OF SERVICE) RULES, 1974

1. **Short title**—These rules may be called the Newspaper Employees (Conditions of Service) Rules, 1974.

2. **Conditions of service of Chairman**—(1) The Chairman shall be entitled to such salary as is admissible to a judge of the Supreme Court.

(2) The Chairman shall be entitled to a rent-free Government accommodation or a house allowance of Taka 1,500 per mensem in lieu thereof.

(3) The Chairman shall be entitled to free Government transport for attending office or to discharge other official functions on such conditions as may be determined by the Government.

(4) The Chairman shall be entitled to such travelling allowance and medical facilities as are admissible to a judge of the Supreme Court.



3. **Fees and travelling allowance of members**—(1) A member, other than the Chairman, shall be entitled to receive daily allowance at the rate of Taka 25 for attending any meeting of the Board or of any Committee thereof.

(2) A member, other than the Chairman, shall be entitled to such travelling allowance as is admissible to Class I Gazetted Officer of the Government.

4. **Meetings**—(1) The meetings of the Board shall be held at such times and places as the Chairman may direct.

(2) All meetings of the Board shall be presided over by the Chairman, and in his absence, by a member authorised by him.

(3) To constitute a quorum at a meeting of the Board, not less than three Members, including at least one representing the employers and another representing the newspaper employees, shall be present.

5. **Disposal of Business**—(1) All questions at a meeting of the Board, shall be decided by a majority of the members present and voting, and in case of equality of votes, the person presiding shall have a second or casting vote.

(2) Voting at a meeting of the Board may be open or secret as the person presiding may decide.

6. **Minutes of Meetings**—(1) The minutes of each meeting of the Board shall show the names of the members present and shall be recorded in such manner as may be directed by the Chairman.

(2) A copy of the minutes shall be communicated to the Government and to each member within seven days of the signing thereof by the Chairman.

(3) The minutes of each meeting shall be confirmed at the next meeting of the Board.

7. **Powers of the Board to collect information**—The Chairman or any member of the Board or any person authorised by the Chairman in writing in this behalf, may, for the purpose of collecting any information necessary for the fixation of wages of any newspaper employees—

- (a) enter, after notice in writing, any premises;
- (b) require the production of any paper or register or any other document;
- (c) take statements of any person; and
- (d) issue questionnaires.

8. **Committees**—The Board may appoint such committees as may be necessary from amongst its members to assist it in the performance of its functions.

9. **Staff**—The Government may appoint a Secretary of the Board and such other staff as it thinks necessary for the performance of functions of the Board.

10. Procedure for fixing rates of wages—(1) Before determining rates of wage in respect of any newspaper employee, the Board shall publish the proposed rates in the official Gazette together with a notice inviting objections or suggestions, if any, from persons likely to be affected thereby within such time as may be specified therein.

(2) The Board shall, after considering the objections or suggestions, if any, received by it under sub-rule (1), make such amendments or modifications in the proposed rates published under sub-rule (1) as it may deem necessary and fix the rates of wages accordingly.
