Dacca, the 12th January 1976.

No. S.R.O. 22-L/76-Nirdesh-8/75-31-Bohi(1).—In exercise of the powers conferred by Article 17 of the Bangladesh Passport Order, 1973 (P.O. No. 9 of 1973), the Government is pleased to make the following amendment in the Bangladesh Passport Rules, 1974, namely:—

In the aforesaid Rules, after rule 5, the following new rule 5A shall be inserted, namely:—

“5A. Restriction on visits to certain foreign countries.—(1) No international or special passport shall be valid for more than two visits to India, Pakistan, Nepal, Ceylon and Burma during a calendar year.

(2) Nothing in sub-rule (1) shall apply—

(a) in the case of a Government servant or any other person visiting the countries on official duty; and

(b) In the case of a businessman or an industrialist visiting the countries after obtaining a no objection certificate from the Ministry of Home Affairs on the recommendation of the Ministry concerned.

(3) Any person visiting a country mentioned in sub-rule (1) shall, if the period of his stay in such country exceeds or is likely to exceed more than sixty days, register himself with the Bangladesh Mission or Consulate, if any, in that country”.
