NOTIFICATION

Dacca, the 19th January, 1977.

No. S.R.O. 24-L/77/PP-1/C-5/76/16. — In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 133 of the Constitution of the People's Republic of Bangladesh, the President, after consultation with the Bangladesh Public Service (Second) Commission as required by clause (2) of article 140 of that Constitution, is pleased to make the following rules, namely:—

1. **Short title.**—These Rules may be called the Non-Gazetted Employees (Directorate of Population Control and Family Planning) Recruitment Rules, 1976.

2. **Definitions.**—In these rules, unless there is anything repugnant in the subject or context:—

(a) "appointing authority" means the Director-General of the Directorate of Population Control and Family Planning and includes, in relation to any specified post or class of such posts, any other officer authorised by the Government to make appointment to such post or class of posts;

(b) "Commission" means the Bangladesh Public Service (Second) Commission;

- (c) "Probationer" means a person appointed on probation to a specified post;
- (d) "requisite qualification", in relation to a specified post, means the qualification laid down in the schedule in relation to that post;
- (e) "Schedule" means the schedule annexed to those rules; and
- (f) "specified post" means a post specified in the Schedule.

3. **Procedure for recruitment.**—(1) Subject to the provisions of the Schedule, appointment to a specified post shall be made—

- (a) by Absorption of the surplus staff of the former Family Planning Council or Family Planning Board; or
- (b) when none is found suitable and qualified for absorption—
 - (i) by direct recruitment; or
 - (ii) by promotion.

(2) No person shall be appointed to a specified post unless he has requisite qualification, and in the case of direct recruitment, he is also within the age limit, if any, laid down in the Schedule for that post.

4. **Appointment.**—(1) All appointment to a specified post shall be made by the appointing authority—

- (a) in the case of absorption or promotion, in consultation with the Commission, and
- (b) in the case of direct recruitment, upon the recommendation of the Commission.

(2) No person shall be eligible for appointment to a specified post by direct recruitment, if he—

- (a) is not a citizen of Bangladesh, or a permanent resident of, or domiciled in Bangladesh;
- (b) is married to, or has entered into a promise of marriage with a person who is not a citizen of Bangladesh.

(3) No appointment to a specified post shall be made by direct recruitment until—

- (a) the person selected for appointment is certified by a Medical Board set up for the purpose by the Director of Health Services to be medically fit for such appointment and that he does not suffer from any such organic defect as is likely to interfere with the discharge of the duties of the post; and
- (b) the antecedents of the persons so selected have been verified through appropriate agencies and found to be such as do not render him unfit for appointment to Government service.

5. **Probation.**—(1) Persons selected for appointment to a specified post otherwise than by absorption or deputation against a substantive vacancy shall be appointed on probation—

- (a) in the case of direct recruitment, for a period of two years from the date of substantive appointment; and
- (b) in the case of promotion, for a period of one year from the date of such appointment;

Provided that the appointing authority may, for reason to be recommended in writing, extend the period or periods so that the extended period does not exceed two years in the aggregate.

(2) After the completion of the period of probation, or the extended period thereof, the appointing authority—

- (a) if he is satisfied that the conduct and work of the probationer during his period of probation has been satisfactory, shall confirm him: and
- (b) if it is of opinion that the conduct and work of the probationer during that period was not satisfactory,—
 - (i) in the case of direct recruitment, terminate his service, and
 - (ii) in the case of promotion, revert him to the post from which he was promoted.

In the aforesaid Rules,—

(1) in rule 32, in sub-rule (1), after clause (b), the following new clause (bb) shall be inserted, namely:—

“(bb) the Collector may, by order in writing, specify the shortest routes to be followed for the transportation of tobacco from a growing

area to any consuming area by road, motor vehicle, river or canal"; and

(2) in rule 200, the existing provision shall be numbered as sub-rule (1) and after sub-rule (1) re-numbered as aforesaid, the following new sub-rule (2) shall be added, namely:—

"(2) For the purposes of sub-rule (1), the Collector may, by notification in the official Gazette, declare a place to be a preventive check-post in any important route of transportation of excisable goods."

NOTIFICATION

Dacca, the 24th January, 1977.

No. S.R.O. 38-L/77/321/D/Cus/77.—In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (c) of section 21 of the Customs Act, 1969 (IV of 1969), the National Board of Revenue is pleased to authorize repayment to the extent specified in column (3) of the table below of Customs duties paid on the importation of the raw materials specified in column (1) of the said table and used in the production or manufacture of the goods specified in column (2) thereof, subject to the following conditions, namely:—

- (i) The goods have been manufactured according to the formula duly furnished to the National Board of Revenue showing the quantity of various imported raw materials specified in column (1) of the said table and used in the production or manufacture of the goods specified in column (2) thereof.

- (ii) The manufacturer maintains proper record of the goods manufactured in accordance with the formula referred to in sub-paragraph (i) and produces, on demand, such records and other evidence as may be required by the National Board of Revenue to satisfy itself that the imported raw materials have been used in accordance with the formula.
- (iii) The manufactured goods are exported out of Bangladesh and an application for repayment of Customs duties is presented to the proper officer of Customs within 60 days of such exportation or of the publication of this notification, whichever is the later.
- (iv) The exporter makes a declaration on the reverse of the original shipping bill or other export documents to the effect that he would claim repayment of the Customs duties paid on the imported raw materials used in the production of the goods being exported.
- (v) The repayment at the rate specified shall be allowed provided that the goods exported are manufactured with the same constituents on which the rate of repayment is notified and the manufacturer-cum-exporter shall immediately intimate to the National Board of Revenue and the Directorate of Inspection and Training (Customs and Excise), Dacca:
- any change in the process of the imported raw materials,
 - any changes in the composition of the manufactured goods to be exported, and
 - use of any indigenous raw material in place of the imported raw materials.

2. The repayment authorized by this Notification shall be admissible in respect of the goods exported on or after the 30th May, 1975.
