No. S.R.O. 24-L/84.—In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 23 of the Bangladesh Standards Institution Ordinance, 1977 (XXXIX of 1977), the Government, in consultation with the Bangladesh Standards Institution, is pleased to prohibit with effect from 1st May, 1984, the sale and distribution of "plywood tea chests" which do not conform to the Bangladesh Standard established by the said Institution in relation to those articles and do not bear the Standard Mark "BDS 18 : 1978".

No. S.R.O. 25-L/84.—In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 22 of the Bangladesh Standards Institution Ordinance, 1977 (XXXIX of 1977), the Government, in consultation with the Bangladesh Standards Institution, is pleased to prohibit with effect from 1st May, 1984, the taking out of Bangladesh of "plywood tea chests" which do not bear the Standard Mark "BDS 18 : 1978."
