O. 33-L/75/S-V. 7(I)/70-71-JD.—In exercise of the powers conferred by and under Section 8A of the Jute Ordinance, 1962 (LXXIV of 1962) the Government, in supersession of the Jute Division's Notification No. Gen. 7(I)/70-71-JD, dated the 4th September 1973 and its corrigendum No. Gen. 7(I)/70-71-JD, dated 24th December 1973, is pleased to direct that with effect from

1st January 1975 and until further orders, charges for baling loose jute in pucca presses shall not exceed Taka 7.75 per bale of 400 lbs., exclusive of godown rent and that annual rent of godowns made available to baler tenants in pucca press houses shall not exceed Taka 2.50 per sq. ft. of Class I godown, Taka 2.00 per sq. ft. of Class II godown and Taka 1.50 per sq. ft. of Class III godown, inclusive of such standard facilities as office-accommodation a 'Chumti-Ghar' and lighting arrangements for each baler tenant provided that charges for extra facilities like railway-sidings, staff-quarters, etc., may be realised from tenants by press-occupiers on mutually agreed terms.

Explanation—(i) The size of the bale in the case of long jute and mesta shall not exceed 10.8 cubic feet and in the case of cuttings 11.4 cubic feet.

(ii) Class I, Class II, Class III godown means godown so classified for insurance purposes.
