No. S.R.O. 46-L/86/Khama/A-1/4R-2/85-88.—In pursuance of the Proclamation of the 24th March, 1982 and in exercise of all powers enabling him in that behalf, the President is pleased to make the following rules, namely:—

THE FOOD DIVISION (FOOD CELL) RECRUITMENT RULES, 1984

- 1. Short title.—These rules may be called the Food Division (Food Cell) Recruitment Rules, 1984.
- 2. Definitions.—In these rules, unless there is anything repugnant in the subject or context:—
 - (a) 'Appointing Authority' means the Government and includes in relation to any specified post, any officer authorised by the Government in this behalf;
 - (b) 'Commission' means the Bangladesh Public Service Commission;
 - (c) 'Schedule' means the schedule annexed to these rules;
 - (d) 'Specified post' means post specified in the schedule.

3. Procedure for Recruitment.—Subject to the provision of the schedule appointment to a specified post shall be made by the appointing authority by transfer on deputation.

Age Limit for direct Recruitment. Method of Recruitment

1 Section Chief, Food Cell (1) Pay: Tk. 2100-2600

By transfer on deputation of an Officer of BCS (Admn: Food) Cadre not below the rank of Director or BCS (Admn: Admn) Cadre or other cadres not below the rank of Deputy Secretary.

2 Deputy Chief, Food Cell (1) Pay: Tk. 1850—2375 By transfer on deputation of an Officer of B.C.S. (Admn: Food) Cadre or B.C.S. (Admn: Admn) Cadre or other cadres having 10 years class-I service.

3 Assistant Chief, Food Cell (1) Pay: Tk. 1400—2225 By transfer on deputation of an Officer of B.C.S. (Admn: Food) Cadre or B.C.S. (Admn: Admn) Cadre or other cadre having 8 years Class-I service.
