# NOTIFICATION

Dacca, the 25th February, 1980

No. S.R.O. 56-L/80/527/Cus.—In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (7) of section 25 of the Customs Act, 1969 (IV of 1969), the Government is pleased to fix tariff value for 'fents' as follows:—

(i) Shirtings, all sorts

Taka 84.00 per kg.

(ii) Suitings, all sorts

Taka 110.00 per kg.

Explanation—For the purposes of this Notification, the term 'fents' means bona fide remnants of piece goods and other fabrics or pieces of fabrics with defects of weaving, dyeing or printing and in no case exceeding two yards in length. Any consignment containing less than sixty five per cent defective pieces as aforesaid or over thirty five per cent sound pieces of the same length would be taken to mean that sound fabrics have been deliberately cut to pieces to give an appearance of fents and shall make such consignment ineligible for consideration as fents.

2. This Notification shall take effect on the 16th day of April, 1980.

## NOTIFICATION

# Dacca, the 22nd February, 1980

No. S.R.O. 58-L/80/CAS-1/14(1)/79.—The following draft of certain further amendments to the Aircraft Rules, 1937, which it is proposed to make in exercise of the powers conferred by section 5 of the Civil Aviation Ordinance, 1960 (XXXII of 1960), is hereby published as required by sub-section (2) of section 15 of the said Ordinance for the information of all persons likely to be affected thereby and notice is hereby given that the said draft will be taken into consideration after a period of three months from the date of publication of this Notification in the official Gazette.

Any objection or suggestion which may be received from any person with respect to the said draft before the expiry of the aforesaid period will be duly considered by the Government.

# Draft Amendments

In the aforesaid Rules,—
(a) for rule 45, the following shall be substituted, namely;—

"45. (1) The following fees shall be payable in respect of the issue, validation or renewal of licences by members of operating crew of an aircraft:

\*For flying tests, the candidate may provide his own aircraft and pay all charges incurred thereby, and in addition he shall pay, when an official examiner is carried on board during the flying test, a fee at the rate of Taka 250 for each hour or part of an hour, so flown. In case the aircraft is provided by the Director Gereral of Civil Aviation, the candidate shall be required to pay the operating cost per hour of that aircraft which would be inclusive of the official examiner's fees if carried.

- (2) An application for any licence or for the renewal or validation of any licence shall be accompanied by a Treasury receipt for the sum necessary to cover all the fees payable except the fees for the official medical examination which shall be payable direct to the medical examiner.
- ( ) In any case when a licence is not issued or renewed or validated the Government may refund to the applicant such proportion of the sum paid as represents the cost of any examination not carried out or any licence not issued." and
- (b) for rule 62, the following shall be substituted, namely:
  - "62. (1) The following fees shall be payable in respect of Certificate of Airworthiness and Ground Engineer's Licences, the validation offoreign certificates of airworthiness, the issue of duplicate certificates of airworthiness and the approval of desgin organisations, inspection organisations and stockists and distributors.

# (a) CERTIFICATES OF AIRWORTHINESS.

# (b) GROUND ENGINEER'S LICENCES

- (iii) For each oral examination not in conjunction Taka twenty-five. with a written paper required in relation to the issue, renewal or extension of a Ground Engineer's licence.

# (c) DESIGN ORGANISATIONS.

- (i) For the grant or approval or a design organisa- Taka one thousand.
- (ii) The annual charge for the maintenance or Taka five hundred. approval of a design organisation.

# (d) INSPECTION ORGANISATION

- (i) For the grant of approval of an inspection Taka one thousand. organisation.
- (ii) Annual charge for the maintenance of approval Taka five hundred. of an inspection organisation.

# (e) STOCKISTS AND DISTRIBUTORS

- For the grant of approval of an organisation Taka five hundred. as stockists and distributors only.
- (ii) The annual charge for the maintenance of Taka two hundred and approval of an organisation as stockists and fifty. distributors only.
  - (2) The Government may remit or reduce the amount of the fee chargeable under sub-rule (1).
  - (3) An application for the purpose for which a fee is payable under this rule shall be accompanied by a Treasury Receipt for the amount payable therefor but in a case where the licence or certificate is not issued or the approval is not given such part of the amount paid that may represent the cost of any examination or inspection paid for but not carried out may if the Government thinks fit be refunded."
