No. S.R.O. 63-L/84.—In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 60 of the Income-tax Act, 1922 (XI of 1922), the Government is pleased to exempt the expatriate personnel engaged in the construction work of Hotel Sonargaon, Dhaka, from so much of the tax on their income chargeable under the head "Salaries", received or deemed to be received by, or accruing or arising or deemed to accrue or arise to, them in Bangladesh, as exceeds the tax that would have been payable by them, had the said Hotel Sonargaon, Dhaka, not agreed to pay such tax on their behalf.
