NOTIFICATION

Dacca, the 30th March, 1978.

No. S.R.O. 64-L/78.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 133 of the Constitution of the People's Republic of Bangladesh, the President, after consultation with the Bangladesh Public Service Commission as required by clause (2) of article 140 of that Constitution, is pleased to make the following rules, namely:—

THE GAZETTED CLASS II OFFICERS (CO-ORDINATION AND CONTROL CELL FOR NATIONAL SECURITY OF PRESIDENT'S SECRETARIAT) RECRUITMENT RULES, 1978

- Short title.—These rules may be called the Gazetted Class II Officers (Co-ordination and Control Cell for National Security of President's Secretariat) Recruitment Rules, 1978.
- 2. Definitions.—In these rules, unless there is anything repugnant in the subject or context,—
 - (a) "appointing authority" means the Government and includes any officer authorised by Government to make appointment to a specified post;

- (b) "Commission" means the Bangladesh Public Service Commission;
- (c) "Probationer" means a person appointed on probation to a specified post;
- (d) "recognised University" means a University established by or under any law for the time being in force and includes any other University declared by Government, after consultation with the Commission to be a recognised University for the purpose of these rules;
- (e) "requisite qualification" in relation to a specified post, means the qualification laid down in the Schedule in relation to that post;
- (f) "Schedule" means the Schedule annexed to these rules;
- (g) "specified post" means a post specified in the Schedule.
- 3. Procedure of recruitment.—(1) Subject to the provisions of the Schedule and such instructions relating to reservation for the purpose of clause (3) of article 29 of the Constitution of the People's Republic of Bangladesh, appointment to a specified post shall be made—
 - (a) by direct recruitment; or
 - (b) by promotion; or
 - (c) by transfer on deputation.
- (2) No person shall be appointed by direct recruitment to a specified post unless he has the requisite qualification and is also within the age limit, if any, specified in the Schedule for that post.
- 4. Appointment by direct recruitment.—(1) No appointment to a specified post by direct recruitment shall be made except upon the recommendation of the Commission.
- (2) No person shall be eligible for appointment to a specified post by direct recruitment, if he—
 - is not a citizen of Bangladesh, or a permanent resident of, or domiciled in, Ban-Jadesh;
 - (b) is married to, or has entered into a promise of marriage with, a person who is not a citizen of Bangladesh.
- (c) No appointment to a specified post by direct recruitment shall be made until-
 - (a) the person selected for appointment is certified by a Medical Board set up for the purpose by the Director of Health Services to be medically fit for such appointment and that he does not suffer from any such organic defect as is likely to interiore with the discharge of the duties of the specified post; and
 - (b) the antecedents of the person so selected have been verified through appropriate agencies and found to be such as do not render him unfit for appointment in the service of the Republic.

- (4) No person shall be recommended for appointment to a specified post unless—
 - (a) he applied in such form, accompanied by such fee and before such date as was notified by the Commission while inviting applications for the post; and
 - (b) in the case of a person already in Government service or in the service or a local authority, he applied through his official superior.
- 5. Appointment by promotion.—Appointment by promotion to a specified post shall be made by the appointing authority after considering the recommendation of the Selection Board constituted for the purpose by the Government and in consultation with the Commission.
- 6. Probation.—(1) Persons selected for appointment to a specified post otherwise than by transfer on deputation against a substantive vacancy shall be appointed on probation—
 - (a) in the case of direct recruitment for a period of two years from the date of substantive appointment; and
 - (b) in the case of promotion, for a period of one year from the date of such appointment;

Provided that the appointing authority may, for reasons to be recorded in writing, extend the period of probation in the case of any person by a period or periods so that the extended period does not exceed two years in the aggregate.

- (2) Where, during the period of probation of a probationer, the appointing cuthority is of opinion that his conduct and work is unsatisfactory or that he is not likely to become efficient, it may, before the expiry of that period—
 - (a) in the case of direct recruitment, terminate his service; and
 - (b) in the case of promotion, revert him to the post from which he was promoted.
- (3) After the completion of the period of probation including the extended period, if any the appointing authority,—
 - (a) if it is satisfied that the conduct and work of the probationer during his period of probation has been satisfactory, shall, subject to the provisions of sub-rule (4), confirm him; and
 - (b) if it is of opinion that the conduct and work of the probationer during that period was not satisfactory, may—
 - (i) in the case of direct recruitment, terminate his service, and
 - (ii) in the case of promotion, revert him to the post from which he was promoted.
- (4) A probationer shall not be confirmed in a specified post until he has passed such examination and training as the Government may, from time to time, direct.
