**NOTIFICATION**

**Dhaka, the 13th February, 1985**

**No. S.R.O. 86-L/85.**—In pursuance of the Proclamation of the 24th of March, 1982 and in exercise of all powers enabling him in that behalf, the President, after consultation with the Bangladesh Public Service Commission, is pleased to make the following rules, namely—

**THE AGRICULTURE INFORMATION SERVICE (TECHNICAL AND NON-TECHNICAL POSTS) RECRUITMENT RULES, 1984.**

1. **Short title** :—These rules may be called The Agriculture Information Service (Technical and Non-Technical posts) Recruitment Rules, 1984.

2. **Definitions** :—In these rules, unless there is anything repugnant in the subject or context,—

- (a) “appointing authority” means the Government and includes, in relation to any specified post or class of such posts, any officer authorised by the Government to make appointment to such post or class of posts;
- (b) “commission” means the Bangladesh Public Service Commission;
- (c) “probation” means person appointed on probation to a specified post;
- (d) “recognised University” means a University established by or under any law for the time being in force and includes, any other University declared by the Government, after consultation with the Commission, to be a recognised University for the purpose of these rules;
- (e) “requisite Qualification” in relation to a specified post, means the qualification laid down in the schedule in relation to that post;
- (f) “schedule” means the Schedule annexed to these rules; and
- (g) “specified post” means post specified in the Schedules.



**3. Procedure for recruitment.**—(1) Subject to the provisions of the Schedule and instructions relating to reservation and quota, appointment to a specified post shall be made—

- (a) by direct recruitment ;
- (b) by promotion ; or
- (c) by transfer on deputation.

(2) No person shall be appointed to a specified post unless he has the requisite qualification and, in the case of direct recruitment, he is also within the age limit laid down in the Schedule for that post.

**4. Appointment by direct recruitment.**—(1) No appointment to a specified post by direct recruitment shall be made except upon the recommendation of the Commission.

(2) No person shall be eligible for appointment to a specified post by direct recruitment, if he—

- (a) is not a citizen of Bangladesh, or a permanent resident of, or domiciled in, Bangladesh ; and
- (b) is married to, or has entered into a promise of marriage with a person who is not a citizen of Bangladesh.

(3) No appointment to a specified post by direct recruitment shall be made until—

- (a) the person selected for appointment is certified by the Civil Surgeon or authorised Medical Officer to be medically fit for such appointment and that he does not suffer from any such organic defect as is likely to interfere with the discharge of the duties of the specified post ; and
- (b) the antecedents of the person so selected have been verified through appropriate agencies and found to be such as do not render him unfit for appointment in the service of the Republic.

(4) No person shall be recommended for appointment to a specified post unless—

- (a) he applied in such form, accompanied by such fee and before such date, as was notified by the Commission while inviting applications for the specified post ; and
- (b) in the case of a person already in Government service or in the service of a local authority, he applied through his official superior.

**5. Appointment by promotion.**—(1) Appointment by promotion to a specified post shall be made on the recommendation of such Departmental Promotion Committee as the Government may constitute in this behalf :

Provided that appointment by promotion to a specified post of higher class shall be made on the recommendation of the Commission.

(2) A person shall not be eligible for appointment by promotion to a specified post if he has unsatisfactory records of service.



6. Probation.—(1) Persons selected for appointment to a specified post against a substantive vacancy shall be appointed on probation,—

- (a) in the case of direct recruitment, for a period of two years from the date of substantive appointment; and
- (b) in the case of promotion, for a period of one year from the date of such appointment:

Provided that the appointment authority may, for reasons to be recorded in writing, extend the period of probation by a period/or periods so that the extended period does not exceed two years in the aggregate.

(2) Where, during the period of probation of a probationer, the appointing authority is of opinion that his conduct and work is unsatisfactory or that he is not likely to become efficient, it may, before the expiry of that period—

- (a) in the case of direct recruitment, terminate his service; and
- (b) in the case of promotion, revert him to the post from which he was promoted.

(3) After the completion of the period of probation including the extended period, if any, the appointing authority,—

- (a) if it is satisfied that the conduct and work of the probationer during his period of probation has been satisfactory, shall, subject to the provisions of sub-rule (4), confirm him; and
- (b) if it is opinion that the conduct and work of the probationer during that period was not satisfactory may,—
  - (i) in the case of direct recruitment, terminate his service; and
  - (ii) in the case of promotion, revert him to the post from which he was promoted.

(4) A probationer shall not be confirmed in a specified post until he was passed such examination and undergone such training as the Government may, from time to time, direct by order.

THE GAZETTED OFFICERS' (DEPARTMENT OF LIVESTOCK SERVICES) RECRUITMENT RULES, 1984.

1. **Short title.**—These rules may be called the Gazetted Officers' (Department of Livestock Services) Recruitment Rules, 1984.

2. **Definitions.**—In these rules unless there is anything repugnant in the subject of context,—

- (a) "appointing authority" means the Government and includes, in relation to any specified post or class of such posts, any officer authorised by Government to make appointment to such posts or class of posts;
- (b) "Commission" means the Bangladesh Public Service Commission;
- (c) "probationer" means a person appointed on probation to a specified post against a substantive vacancy;
- (d) "recognised University" means a University established by or under any law for the time being in force and includes any other University declared by Government after consultation with the Commission to be a recognised University for the purpose of these rules;
- (e) "requisite qualification" in relation to a specified post means the qualification prescribed in the Schedule in relation to that post;
- (f) "Schedule" means a Schedule annexed to these rules; and
- (g) "specified post" means a post specified in the Schedule.

3. **Procedure for recruitment.**—(1) Subject to the provisions of the Schedule and instructions relating to reversion of posts, appointment to a specified post shall be made—

- (a) by direct recruitment;
- (b) by promotion; or
- (c) by transfer on deputation.

(2) No person shall be appointed to a specified post unless he has the requisite qualification and, in the case of direct recruitment, he is within the age limit prescribed in the Schedule for that post.



4. **Appointment by direct recruitment.**—(1) No appointment to a specified post by direct recruitment shall be made except upon the recommendation of the Commission.

(2) No person shall be eligible for appointment to a specified post by direct recruitment, if he—

- (a) is not a citizen of Bangladesh or a permanent resident of, or domiciled in Bangladesh:

Provided that this clause shall not apply in the case of a person who is already in the service of the Republic.

- (b) is married to a person who is not a citizen of Bangladesh.

(3) No appointment to a specified post by direct recruitment shall be made until—

- (a) the person selected for appointment is certified by a Medical Board or Medical Officer set up or authorised for the purpose by the Director General of Health Services to be medically fit for such appointment and that he does not suffer from any such organic defect as is likely to interfere with the discharge of the duties of the post; and
- (b) the antecedents of the person so selected have been verified through appropriate agencies and found to be such as do not render him unfit for appointment in the service of the Republic.

5. **Appointment by promotion.**—(1) Appointment by promotion to the specified post shall be made on the recommendation of such departmental promotion committee as the Government may constitute in this behalf:

Provided that appointment by promotion to a specified post of higher class shall be made on the recommendation of the Commission.

(2) A person shall not be eligible for promotion, if he has unsatisfactory records of service.

6. **Probation.**—(1) Persons selected for appointment to a specified post otherwise than by transfer of service, against a substantive vacancy shall be appointed on probation—

- (a) in the case of direct recruitment, for a period of two years from the date of substantive appointment; and

- (b) in the case of promotion, for a period of one year from the date of such appointment:

Provided that the appointing authority may extend the period of probation by a period or periods so that the extended period does not exceed two years in the aggregate.

(2) Where, during the period of probation of a probationer, the appointing authority is of opinion that his conduct and work is unsatisfactory or that he is not likely to become efficient it may, before the expiry of that period:—

- (a) in the case of direct recruitment, terminate the service of the probationer; and

- (b) in the case of promotion, revert him to the post from which he was promoted.

NOTIFICATION

Dhaka, the 13th February, 1985

**No. S. R. O. 88-L/85/906/Cus.**—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 219 of the Customs Act, 1969 (IV of 1969), and in supersession of the Privileged Persons' Baggage Rules, 1974, the National Board of Revenue is pleased to make the following rules, namely:—

THE PRIVILEGED PERSONS' BAGGAGE RULES, 1985

1. **Short title.**—These rules may be called the Privileged Persons' Baggage Rules, 1985.

2. **Definition.**—In these rules, unless there is anything repugnant in the subject or context, "privileged person" means—

- (a) a non-Bangladeshi official of the United Nations or an organisation thereunder in Bangladesh or an expert performing functions on behalf of the United Nations or any organisation under the United Nations and entitled to privileges under the Convention of Privileges and Immunities of the United Nations adopted by the General Assembly on the 13th February, 1946, and holding United Nations laissezpasser;
- (b) an official of any specialised agency of the United Nations located in Bangladesh and entitled to privileges under the Convention of the Privileges and Immunities of the Specialised Agencies adopted by the General Assembly on the 21st November, 1947;
- (c) a foreign national working in Bangladesh as a consultant or expert under—
  - (i) any agreement between him and the Government, or
  - (ii) any agreement between the Government and a foreign Government or a foreign or international organisation or agency, or
  - (iii) any agreement between any authority, institution or agency in Bangladesh and a foreign or international organisation or agency for the purpose of planning, designing and supervision of any project or any technical assistance programme approved by the Government.

3. **Import of articles free of customs duties, etc.**—(1) A privileged person shall be entitled to import free of customs duties—

- (a) articles of foodstuff and other consumable stores including medicines of the value specified in the Table of Notification No. S.R.O. 89-L/85/907/Cus., dated the 13th February, 1985;



- (b) articles of personal and household effects including video-cassette recorders, video-camera and video-tapes if his continuous stay in Bangladesh is expected to be not less than six months:

Provided that the import of miscellaneous and sundry household items of semi-durable and breakable nature shall be limited to a maximum value of taka twenty thousand for the first year of his stay;

- (c) a motor car for his personal and family use provided his continuous stay in Bangladesh is expected to be not less than one year.

(2) The unaccompanied personal and household effects or articles, if any, may be imported within six months from the date of his first arrival in Bangladesh:

Provided that this time limit may, on satisfactory grounds, be extended by another six months by the Collector of Customs concerned and beyond that period by the Board:

Provided further that the privileged person, at the time of his arrival in Bangladesh, makes a declaration in respect of both accompanied and unaccompanied personal and household effects and other articles in Form 'A' annexed to these rules.

(3) A privileged person staying in Bangladesh continuously for more than a year may be allowed to import miscellaneous and sundry household items of non-durable nature up to the value of taka ten thousand per year for another two years without the formalities of filling up of 'A' Form.

4. **Issue of pass book.**—(1) A privileged person shall submit his application to the National Board of Revenue or to such officer of Customs as the Board may designate through his Head of Office in case he is an official in a United Nations body or specialised agency and, in case of person under clause (c) of rule 2, through his employer and the administrative Ministry dealing with the agreement for issue of a pass book.

(2) The National Board of Revenue or the designated officer of Customs may, after considering the application, direct the concerned Joint Collector of Customs to issue a pass book in such form as may be specified by the Board.

(3) The fact of issue of pass book shall be entered in the passport of the privileged person.

(4) All articles imported by a privileged person on his first arrival in Bangladesh or purchase free of Customs duties subsequently shall be entered in his pass book.

(5) The pass book issued to a privileged person shall remain valid for a period of one year from the date of issue or till the month of January next, whichever is earlier.

(6) The pass book may be renewed on receipt of a certificate from the Head of Office or, as the case may be, the employer referred to in sub-rule (1) to the effect that the holder of the pass book continues to be in his assignment in Bangladesh specifying the period he is likely to continue with his assignment.



(7) Notwithstanding anything contained in these rules, no privileged person shall be issued pass book under this rule unless his stay in Bangladesh is not less than a continuous period of sixty days.

**5. Disposal of cars, etc.—**(1) A car imported by a privileged person or purchased with the concurrence of the Joint Collector of Customs, Custom House, Dhaka or Chittagong from another privileged person free of customs duties shall, if not re-exported, be disposed of in such manner as may be laid down by the Board from time to time.

(2) The registration number of the car imported by a privileged person or purchased with the concurrence of the Joint Collector of Customs, Custom House, Dhaka or Chittagong from another privileged person free of customs duties shall be intimated by the organisation to which he is attached to the Collector of Customs of the area within ten days of its registration or purchase, as the case may be, and the Collector of Customs shall maintain a register for, and keep vigilance over, such cars.

(3) Any durable articles, including air-conditioner, video-cassette recorder, video-camera, video-tapes, refrigerator, radiogram, tape recorder and washing-machine, other than a car imported by the privileged person or purchased with the concurrence of the Joint Collector of Customs, Custom House, Dhaka or Chittagong from another privileged person free of customs duties shall not be disposed of by sale or otherwise, if such articles are not re-exported, without obtaining the prior permission of the Board and except in such manner and subject to such conditions as may be laid down by the Board from time to time.

(4) If any durable articles, including air-conditioner, video-cassette recorders, video-camera, Video-tapes, refrigerator, radiogram, tape recorder or washing machine, imported by a privileged person or purchased from another privileged person free of customs duties are disposed of by sale or otherwise, customs duties shall be payable at the rates applicable to such articles at the time of initial importation.

(5) The fact of the disposal of car and other durable articles or their re-exportation, as the case may be, shall be entered in the pass book of the privileged person by the appropriate officer.

**6. Surrender of pass book.—**(1) A privileged person shall surrender his pass book to the appropriate officer at the time of his final departure from Bangladesh and the appropriate officer shall verify if the car and other durable articles have been exported out of Bangladesh or disposed of in the manner laid down by the Board, and after such verification, shall issue a clearance certificate.

(2) A privileged person shall produce, at the time of departure from Bangladesh, the clearance certificate issued under sub-rule (1) to the officer of customs at the exist point without which customs clearance shall not be allowed.

## NOTIFICATION

Dhaka, the 13th February, 1985

No. S. R. O. 89-L/85/907/Cus.—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 19 of the Customs Act, 1969 (IV of 1969), and section 4(1) of the Sales Tax Ordinance, 1982 (XVIII of 1982), and in supersession of this Ministry's Notification No. S. R. O. 132/D/Cus/74, dated the 14th March, 1974, the Government is pleased to exempt the goods specified in the Table below imported into Bangladesh by a privileged person from the whole of the customs duties and sales tax chargeable thereon, subject to the following conditions, namely:—

- (i) that the privileged person shall produce to the appropriate officer of customs at the time of clearance of the goods imported by him, his passport and the passports of the members of his family and a certificate from the administrative Ministry or any other person authorised in this behalf by such Ministry to the effect that he and the members of his family will stay in Bangladesh for the whole of the period for which the goods are imported;
- (ii) that the exemption may be availed of by importing the quota specified in the Table below for a maximum period of six months at a time; and
- (iii) that the goods in respect of which exemption is allowed under this Notification shall, on their import, be entered by the appropriate officer of customs in the pass book issued to him by the Joint Collector of Customs of the competent jurisdiction under instructions of the Board or any authority designated by the Board.

2. The quota for the import of liquors and tobacco shall not be available to the members of a privileged person's family whose age is below 18 years.

3. A privileged person, not residing with his family, may be allowed to import 50 per cent higher quota of articles specified in the Table below :

*Explanation.*—For the purposes of this Notification, the term "privileged person" shall have the same meaning as has been assigned to it in the Privileged Persons' Baggage Rules, 1985.
