PUBLIC NOTICE NO.18(75)/IMPORT

Dacca, the 22nd February 1975.

In partial modification of this office Public Notice No.93(74)/Import (Import Trade Control), dated the 16th August 1974, provisions of the Import Policy (January-June, 1975) Order and subsequent relevant Public Notices, it is hereby notified for the information of all concerned that the expression "Non-resident Convertible Taka Account" wherever occurring, shall stand substituted by the expression "Foreign Currency Account" with immediate effect. Advance Import

Permits against such Foreign Currency Accounts will now be issued either in Pound sterling or U.S. dollar, as the case may be, instead of in Taka as hitherto. Advance Import Permits, so issued will be transferable by endorsement to a Bangladesh national or person of Bangladesh origin or a firm/oompany registered in Bangladesh.

- 2. Import Licences against such Advance Import Permits also will henceforth be issued either in Pound sterling or U.S. dollar, as the case may be. Letter of Credit against such Import Licences will be opened only by the bank maintaining the relevant Foreign Currency Account. However, the Advance Import Permit holder will be free to apply for Import Licence through his own bank. Similarly, the Import Licence holder will be free to apply for opening of Letter of Credit through his own bank.
- Advance Import Permits issued in Taka denomination earlier, will be valid for issue of Import Licences in Taka denomination only.
- 4. It is also clarified that other terms and conditions governing issue of Advance Import Permits/Import Licences as laid down in this office Public Notice No.93(74)/Import (Import Trade Control), dated the 16th August 1974, Import Policy (January-June 1975) Order and subsequent relevant Public Notices will remain unchanged.
