NOTIFICATION

Dhaka, the 1st April, 1986

No. S.R.O. 98-L/86.—In exercise of the powers conferred by Article 94 of the Representation of the People Order, 1972 (P.O. No. 155 of 1972), the Government is pleased to make the following further amendment in the Conduct of Elections Rules, 1972, namely :—

In the aforesaid rules, for rule 9 the following shall be *substituted*, namely :—

“9. Symbols.—(1) A contesting candidate may be allocated under clause (I) of Article 20 any one of the following symbols, namely :—
