THE BANGLADESH LAWS (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1975
Ordinance No. XIII of 1975

#### ORDINANCE

to amend and repeal certain laws.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend and repeal certain laws for the purposes hereinafter appearing;

AND WHEREAS Parliament is not in session and the President is satisfied that circumstances exist which render immediate action necessary;

Now, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (I) of Article 93 of the Constitution of the People's Republic of Bangladesh, the President is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:—

- 1. Short title.—(I) The Ordinance may be called the Bangladesh Laws (Amendment) Ordinance, 1975.
- (2) It shall come into force at once and shall be deemed to have taken effect on the 25th day of January, 1975.
- 2. Amendment of E. P. Ordinance II of 1964.—In the Cadet College Ordinance, 1964 (E. P. Ordinance II of 1964), in section 4A, in clause (a), for the words and comma "Prime Minister, Government" the word "President" shall be substituted.
- 3. Amendment of P. O. No. 49 of 1972.—In the Bangladesh Special (Remuneration and Privileges) Order, 1972 (P. O. No. 49 of 1972),—
  - (a) in the preamble, for the words "Ministers of the Cabinet" the words "Members of the Council of Ministers" shall be substituted; and
  - (b) in Article 2, for clause (b), the following shall be substituted, namely;
    - "(b) "Minister" means a member of the Council of Ministers and includes a Minister of State and a Deputy Minister but does not include the Prime Minister;".
- 4. Amendment of P. O. No. 64 of 1972.—In the Bangladesh (Whips) Order, 1972 (P. O. No. 64 of 1972).—
  - (a) in Article 3, in clause (4), for the words "Prime Minister" the word "President" shall be substituted; and
  - (b) Article 6 shall be omitted.
- 5. Amendment of P. O. No. 94 of 1972.—In the Bangladesh (Freedom Fighters) Welfare Trust Order, 1972 (P. O. No. 94 of 1972), in Article 7, in clause (I), in sub-clause (a), the words "nominated by the Prime Minister" shall be omitted.
- 6. Amendment of P. O. No. 22 of 1973.—In the Bangladesh Local Government (Union Parishad and Paurashava) Order, 1973 (P. O. No. 22 of 1973), in the preamble,—
  - (a) the first paragraph shall be omitted; and
    - (b) in the second paragraph, the word "AND" shall be omitted.
- 7. Amendment of Act XII of 1974.—In the Public Servants (Retirement) Act, 1974 (XII of 1974), in section 5, in sub-section (3), for the words "Prime Minister" the word "President" shall be substituted.
- 8. Repeal of Act III of 1962 and P. O. No. 8 of 1973.—The Political Parties Act, 1962 (III of 1962), and the Representation of the People (Supplementary) Order, 1973 (P. O. No. 8 of 1973), are hereby repealed.

#### NATIONAL BOARD OF REVENUE, DACCA

(Income Tax)

#### Dacca, the 10th March 1975.

No. S.R.O. 105-L/77.—In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (5) of section 15D of the Income-tax Act, 1922 (XI of 1922), the National Board of Revenue is pleased to specify the Chittagong Association, Dacca, for the purposes of that section, subject to the following conditions, namely:—

- (a) the accounts of the Association shall be fully audited by a chartered accountant every year; and such audited accounts shall be submitted to the Income-tax Officer in whose territorial jurisdiction the head office of the Association is situated;
- (b) the Association shall not make any donation or grant to any other charitable institution or fund unless such institution or fund has been approved under sub-section (5) of section 15D of the Income-tax Act, 1922;
- (c) in the event of dissolution of the Association, its assets, after meeting its liabilities, if any, shall be transferred to another institution or fund approved under sub-section (5) of section 15D of the Incometax Act, 1922.
