NOTIFICATION

Dacca, the 10th May, 1978

No. S.R.O. 108-L/78.—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 146 of the Paurashava Ordinance, 1977 (XXVI of 1977), read with section 44 thereof, the Government is pleased to make the following amendments in the Local Councils Service Rules, 1968, namely:—

In the aforesaid Rules, in rule 7, in sub-rule (1),—

- (a) in the second paragraph, in clause (b), for the semi-colon at the end a colon shall be substituted and thereafter the following proviso shall be added, namely:—

“Provided that a Paurashava with normal annual income of less than Taka 30 lakhs may, in a case where the Government thinks it appropriate, be categorised as Class I.”; and

- (b) after Explanation 2, the following new explanation shall be added, namely:—

“Explanation 3.—In Schedule II, references to “Municipal Committee” shall be deemed to be references to “Paurashava.”.

IN THE COURT OF THE SUMMARY MARTIAL LAW COURT, DACCA**MLGR No. BAB GR No. 75/76**

Whereas it has been made to appear to the Court that accused Azizur Rahman, son of Mohammad Ershad Ali of village Bargram, P.S. Biani Bazar, district Sylhet and Administrator/Manager, M/s. Eastern Rubber Industries, Tejgaon, Dacca and residence of 56, Tejkunipara, P.S. Tejgaon, Dacca, is/are required for the purpose of trial in the Summary Martial Law Court, Dacca under MLR 11 in connection with Tejgaon P.S. Case No. 19(10)76;

And whereas the Court has reason to believe that the said accused person/persons is/are absconding and concealing himself/themselves to avoid appearance or arrest for the said purpose.

The aforesaid accused person/persons is/are directed to appear in the Summary Martial Law Court, Dacca Collectorate Court Building, Dacca, on 13th May 1978 at 0930 hours failing which he/they will be tried *in absentia* and his/their property part/whole may be confiscated to the State.
