In the aforesaid Notification, in the Table,-

- (a) against Heading No. 51.04 in column(1), for the items (ii) and (iii) in column (2) and the entries relating thereto in column (3), the following shall be substituted, namely:—
 - "(ii) All fabrics made of 100% man-made fibres falling under sub-heads A and B except suitings
 - (iii) others including suitings

- (b) for Heading No. 56.07 in column (1) and the entries relating thereto in columns
 (2) and (3) the following shall be substituted, namely:—
