Abul Kashem, son of late Alhaj Mohammad Hossain of Mulatole, P.S. Kotwali, Dist. Rangpur and (4) Omar Ali, son of Mozam Sk. of 47, B. K. Manir Road, P.S. and Dist. Khulna, are wanted in connection with M.L. Special Case No. 15/77, Kotwali (Rangpur) P.S. Case No. 2, dated 3rd January 1977 6/8. 12 and 11, M.L.R;

And whereas I have reason to believe that the said accused are absconding and are concealing themselves so that they cannot be arrested and produced before this Court for trial.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in me under Regulation 3(7) of M. L. R. 1/1975, I, Lt Col Md. Azizur Rahman, Chairman, Special Martial Law Court, No. V, Rangpur, do hereby direct the aforesaid accused persons to appear before em in my Court within 7 (seven) days from the date of its publication.

It is further ordered that if the said accused persons fail to comply with the above direction, they would be tried in their absence and their proporties would be liable to be forfeited to the Government.
