Dhaka, the 21st March, 1984

No. S.R.O. 118-L/84/829/Cus.—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 19 of the Customs Act, 1969 (IV of 1969) and 4 of the Sales Tax Ordinance, 1982 (XVIII of 1982), the Government is pleased to exempt following spare parts of computer from so much of the customs duties leviable thereon as is in excess of 20% and the whole of sales tax, provided the parts are identifiable as such on the basis of catalogues issued by the Manufacturers of Computers for which these are imported :
