NOTIFICATION

Dhaka, the 11th March, 1985

No. S.R.O. 122-L/85.—In pursuance of the Proclamation of the 24th March 1982, and in exercise of all powers enabling him in that behalf, the President, after consultation with the Bangladesh Public Service Commission, is pleased to make the following rules, namely :—

THE BANGLADESH RAILWAY MEDICAL SERVICE RECRUITMENT RULES, 1985.

1. **Short title.**—These rules may be called The Bangladesh Railway Medical Service Recruitment Rules, 1985.

2. **Definitions.**—In these rules, unless there is anything repugnant in the subject or context,—

- (a) “appointing authority” means the Government and includes, in relation to any specified post or class of such posts, any officer authorised by the Government to make appointment to such post or class of posts;
- (b) “Commission” means the Bangladesh Public Service Commission;
- (c) “recognised University” means a University established by or under any law for the time being in force and includes any other University declared by the Government after consultation with the Commission, to be a recognised University for the purpose of these rules;
- (d) “requisite qualification” in relation to a specified post, means the qualification laid down in the Schedule in relation to that post;
- (e) “Schedule” means the Schedule annexed to these rules; and
- (f) “specified post” means a post specified in the Schedule.

3. **Procedure for recruitment.**—(1) Subject to the provisions of the Schedule and instructions relating to reservation, appointment to a specified post shall be made—

- (a) by direct recruitment; and
- (b) by promotion.

(2) No person shall be appointed to a specified post unless he has the requisite qualification and in the case of direct recruitment he is also within the age limit laid down in the Schedule for the post.

4. **Appointment by direct recruitment.**—(1) No appointment to a specified post by direct recruitment shall be made except upon the recommendation of the Commission.

(2) No person shall be eligible for appointment to a specified post by a direct recruitment, if he—

- (a) is not a citizen of Bangladesh, or a permanent resident of or domiciled in, Bangladesh; and
- (b) is married, or has entered into a promise of marriage with a person who is not a citizen of Bangladesh.

(3) No appointment to a specified post by direct recruitment shall be made until—

- (a) the persons selected for appointment is certified by a Medical Board set up for the purpose to be medically fit for such appointment and that he does not suffer from any such organic defect as is likely to interfere with the discharge of the duties of the specified post; and
- (b) the antecedents of the person so selected have been verified through appropriate agencies and found to be such as do not render him unfit for appointment in the service of the Republic.

(4) No person shall be recommended for appointment to a specified post unless—

- (a) he applied in such form, accompanied by such fee and before such date, as was notified by the Commission while inviting applications for the specified post; and
- (b) in the case of a person already in Government service or in the service of a local authority, he applied through his official superior.

5. **Appointment by promotion.**—Subject to the provisions of Schedule, appointment by promotion to a specified post shall be made on the recommendation of the Superior Selection Board or the Special Promotion Committee, as the case may be, constituted by the Government in this behalf—

- (a) no person shall be eligible for promotion if he has unsatisfactory service records; and
- (b) a person on promotion to a specified post have to qualify in such training course as may be prescribed by the Government, failing which he will be reverted to the post from which he was promoted.

6. **Probation.**—(1) A person initially appointed to a service against a substantive vacancy shall remain on probation for—

- (a) a period of two years if he is appointed by direct recruitment; and
- (b) a period of one year if he is appointed on promotion :

Provided that the period of probation may be extended by the Government for a further period not exceeding two years.

(2) Where, during the period of probation, a probationer is found unsuitable for retention in the concerned service, the Government may without consultation with the Commission—

- (a) in the case of direct recruitment, terminate his service; and
- (b) in the case of promotion, revert him to the post from which he was promoted.

(3) After the completion of the period of probation, including the extended period if any, the appointing authority—

- (a) if it is satisfied that the conduct and work of that probationer during his period of probation has been satisfactory, shall, subject to the provision of sub-rule (4), confirm him; and
- (b) if is of opinion that the conduct and work of the probationer during that period was not satisfactory may,—
 - (i) in case of direct recruitment, terminate his service; and
 - (ii) in the case of promotion, revert him to the post from which he was promoted.

(4) A probationer shall not be confirmed in a specified post until he has passed such examination and undergone such training as the Government, from time to time, direct.
