No. S.R.O. 123-L/77/S-VI/3R-4/77/84.—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 86 of the Local Government Ordinance, 1976 (XC of 1976), the Government is pleased to make the following rules, namely:—

THE UNION PARISHADS (PAYMENT OF HONORARIUM TO CHAIRMAN
RULES, 1977.

1. **Short title.**—These rules may be called the Union Parishads (Payment of Honorarium to Chairman) Rules, 1977.

2. **Payment of honorarium.**—The Chairman of a Union Parishad shall be paid an honorarium of Taka 3,600.00 per annum with effect from the date of his assumption of office of Chairman.

3. **Drawal of honorarium.**—The Chairman shall draw the amount of honorarium from the fund of the Union Parishad either in equal quarterly instalments of Taka 900.00 each or in equal monthly instalments of Taka 300.00 each, as the fund may permit.

4. **Repeal.**—The Union Parishads (Payment of Honorarium to Chairman and Vice-Chairman) Rules, 1974, are hereby *repealed*.

No. S.R.O. 124-L/77 S-VI/3R-6/77 86.—In exercise of the powers conferred by sect on 86 of the Local Government Ordinance, 1976 (XC of 1976), the Government is pleased to make the following amendment in the Village Police Force Rules, 1968, namely:—

In the aforesaid Rules, in rule 8, in sub-rule (1), *after* sub-clause (i), the following new sub-clause (ia) shall be *inserted*, namely:—

“(ia) P.T. shoe both for Mahalladar and Dafadar—one pair.”.
