Whereas it has been made to appear to the Court that accused Md. Liaquat, son of Nazir Ahmed Sikdar of village Iluhar, P. S. Banaripara, Dist. Barisal, at present Tongi Mosjid Market, Prop. of Royal Timber Store, Tongi Bazar, P.S.
