Whereas it has been made to appear to the Court that accused Khjer Ali alias Khepu Biswas, son of Abiswas of Kalabaria, (2) Abdul Majid Sk, son of Gani alias Gann Sk, of Simulia, both of P.S. Mirpur, Dist. Kushtia, is required for the purpose of trial in the Summary Martial Law Court, Kushtia, u/ss. 379/411, BPC in connection with the abovenoted G.R. Case in Mirpur P.S. Case No. 9, dated 23rd March 1973;

And whereas this Court has reason to believe that the said accused persons are absconding or concealing themselves to avoid appearance or arrest for the said purpose;

Now, therefore, in exercise of powers conferred upon me by MLR No. 3(7)/76, I do hereby direct the said accused persons to appear in this Court on or before 12th May 1977, failing which they will be tried in absentia and the whole of their properties may be forfeited to the Government.
