No. S.R.O. 141-L/77.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 133 of the Constitution of the People's Republic of Bangladesh, the President, after consultation with the Public Service (First) Commission as required by clause (.) of article 140 of that Constitution, is pleased to make the following rules, namely:—

**GAZETTED OFFICERS (SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY DIVISION)
RECRUITMENT RULES, 1977.**

1. **Short title**—These rules may be called the Gazetted Officers (Science and Technology Division) Recruitment Rules, 1977.

2. **Definitions.**—In these rules, unless there is anything repugnant in the subject or context,—

- (a) "appointing authority" means the Government;
- (b) "Commission" means the Bangladesh Public Service (First) Commission;
- (c) "probationer" means a person appointed on probation to a specified post;
- (d) "requisite qualification", in relation to a specified post, means the qualification specified in column 5 of the Schedule in relation to that post;

- (e) "recognised university" means a university established by or under any law for the time being in force and includes any other university declared by the Government, after consultation with the Commission, to be recognised university for the purposes of these rules;
- (f) "Schedule" means the Schedule annexed to these rules;
- (g) "specified post" means a post specified in the Schedule; and
- (h) "Superior Selection Board" means the Superior Selection Board constituted in the Establishment Division for selection of persons for appointment to posts bearing the pay which exceeds Taka seventeen hundred.

3. **The method of recruitment.**—(1) Subject to the provisions of the Schedule and such instructions relating to reservation for the purposes of clause (3) of article 29 of the Constitution as the Government may issue from time to time, appointment to a specified post shall be made by direct recruitment or by promotion or by transfer on deputation.

(2) No person shall be appointed to a specified post unless he has the requisite qualifications and, in the case of direct recruitment, he is within the age limit, if any, laid down in the Schedule for the post.

4. **Appointment by promotion or by transfer on deputation.**—(1) Appointment by promotion or by transfer on deputation to a specified post shall be made—

- (a) in a case where the pay exceeds Taka seventeen hundred, through the Superior Selection Board; and
- (b) in a case where the pay does not exceed Taka seventeen hundred through the Departmental Selection Board constituted in this behalf in the Science and Technology Division.

(2) A person shall not be eligible for appointment by promotion to a specified post if he has not been confirmed in any post on the ground of unsatisfactory service records or of his failure to fulfil any other requirement for confirmation to that post.

5. **Appointment by direct recruitment.**—(1) No direct appointment to a specified post shall be made except upon the recommendation of the Commission.

(2) No person shall be eligible for appointment to a specified post if he—

- (a) is not a citizen of Bangladesh;
- (b) is married to, or has entered into a promise of marriage with, a person who is not a citizen of Bangladesh.

(3) No appointment to a specified post by direct recruitment shall be made until—

- (a) the person selected for appointment is certified by a Medical Board set up for the purpose by the Government to be medically fit for such appointment and that he does not suffer from any such organic defect as is likely to interfere with the discharge of the duties of the specified post;

- (b) the antecedents of the person so selected have been verified through appropriate agencies and found to be such as do not render him unfit for appointment in the service of the Republic.

(4) No person shall be recommended for appointment to a specified post unless—

- (a) he applied in such form, accompanied by such fee and before such date, as was notified by the Commission while inviting applications for the post;
- (b) in the case of a person already in the service of the Republic or in the service of any local authority has applied through his official superior.

6. Probation.—(1) Persons selected for appointment to a specified post, otherwise than by transfer on deputation, against a substantive vacancy shall be appointed on probation—

- (a) in the case of direct recruitment, for a period of two years from the date of substantive appointment; and
- (b) in the case of promotion, for a period of one year from the date of such appointment :

Provided that the appointing authority may, for reasons to be recorded in writing, extend the period of probation by a period or periods so that the extended period does not exceed two years in the aggregate.

(2) Soon after the completion of the period of probation, including the extended period, if any, the appointing authority—

- (a) if it is satisfied that the conduct and work of the probationer during his period of probation has been satisfactory, shall confirm him; or
- (b) if it is of opinion that the conduct and work of the probationer during that period was not satisfactory, may, in the case of direct recruitment, terminate his service, and in the case of promotion, revert him to the post from which he was promoted.
