NOTIFICATION

Dacca, the 23rd April 1975.

No. S.R.O. 143-L/75/S-V/1R-6/74/129.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 133 of the Constitution of the People's Republic of Bangladesh, the President, after consultation with the Bangladesh Public Service (Second) Commission as required by clause (2) of Article 140 of that Constitution, is pleased to make the following rules, namely:—

- Short title.—These rules may be called the Non-gazetted Employees (Department of Inspection for Factories and Establishments) Recruitment Rules, 1975.
 - 2. Definitions,-In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires,-
 - (a) "appointing authority" means the Chief Inspector of Factories and Establishments;
 - (b) "Commission" means the Bangladesh Public Service (Second) Commission;
 - (c) "Probationer" means a person appointed on probation to a specified post;
 - (d) "recognised Board" means a Board of Intermediate and Secondary Education established by or under any law for the time being in force and includes any other Board declared by the Government, to be a recognised Board for the purposes of these rules;

- (e) "recognised University" means a University established by or under any law for the time being in force and includes any other University declared by the Government, to be a recognised University for the purpose of these rules;
- (f) "requisite qualification", in relation to a specified post, means the qualification specified in column 3 of the Schedule in relation to that post;
- (g) "Schedule" means the Schedule annexed to these rules;
- (h) "specified post" means a post specified in the Schedule.
- 3. Procedure for recruitment.—(1) Subject to the provisions of the Schedule, appointment to a specified post shall be made—
 - (a) by direct recruitment; or
 - (b) by promotion from amongst persons already holding specified posts.
- (2) No person shall be appointed to a specified post unless he has the requisite qualification, and in the case of direct recruitment, he is within the age limit, if any, specified in the Schedule for that post.
- 4. Appointment by direct recruitment.—(1) All appointments to specified posts by direct recruitment shall be made upon the recommendation of the Commission.
 - (2) No person shall be eligible for appointment to a specified post if he-
 - (a) is not a citizen of Bangladesh or is not a permanent resident of, or domiciled in, Bangladesh;
 - (b) is married to, or has entered into a promise of marriage with, a person who is not a citizen of Bangladesh:

Provided that the President may authorise, on temporary basis, the appointment of a person who is not a citizen of Bangladesh.

- (3) No appointment to a specified post by direct recruitment shall be made until—
 - (a) the person selected for appointment is certified by a medical officer competent to issue medical certificates in terms of rule 14 of the Service Rules, Part I, to be medically fit for such appointment and that he does not suffer from any such organic defect as is likely to interfere with the discharge of the duties of the post;
 - (b) the antecedents of the person so selected have been verified through appropriate agencies and found to be such as do not render him unfit for appointment to Government service.
- (4) No person shall be recommended for appointment to a specified post unless—
 - (a) he applied in such form, accompanied by such fee and before such date, as was notified by the Commission while inviting applications for the post; and
 - (b) in the case of a person already in Government service or in the service of a local authority, he has applied through his official superior.

- Appointment by promotion.—Appointment by promotion to a specified post shall be made after considering the recommendation of the Departmental Selection Board.
- (1) Persons selected for appointment to a specified post against a substantive vacancy shall be appointed on probation,—
 - (a) in the case of direct recruitment, for a period of two years from the date of substantive appointment; and
 - (b) in the case of promotion, for a period of one year from the date of such appointment.
 - (2) After the completion of the period of probation, the appointing authority,—
 - (a) if he is satisfied that the conduct and the work of the probationer have been satisfactory, shall confirm him; and
 - (b) if he is of opinion that the conduct and work of the probationer during that period were not satisfactory,—
 - (i) in the case of direct recruitment, terminate his service; and
 - (ii) in the case of promotion, revert him to the post from which he was promoted.

Explanation.—The period of probation of a probationer shall be deemed to have been extended until any order under this sub-rule has been issued.
