NOTIFICATION

Dhaka, the 23rd March 1985

No. S.R.O. 145-L/85.—In pursuance of the Proclamation of the 24th March, 1982, and in exercise of all powers enabling him in that behalf, the President, after consultation with the Bangladesh Public Service Commission, is pleased to make the following further amendments in the Bangladesh Civil Service Recruitment Rules, 1981, namely:—

In the aforesaid Rules,-

- (a) in rule 5, in the proviso,-
 - (i) for clause (b) the following shall be substituted, namely:--
 - "(b) no person shall be promoted to the New National Scale of Taka 1400—2225 unless he has passed an examination conducted by the Commission and found fit by the Special Promotion Committee;";

- (ii) in clause (c), the words "in a test or examination conducted" shall be omitted; and
- (iii) in clause (f), after the words "specified post" the words and figures "in the New National Scales of Taka 1850—2375, Taka 2100—2600 and Taka 2350—2750" shall be inserted;
- (b) in rule 7, in sub-rule (1),-
 - (i) for the words "A person intially appointed" the words and comma "Subject to sub-rule (3), a person initially appointed" shall be substituted;
 - (ii) for clause (a) the following shall be substituted, namely:-
 - "(a) foundational training for a period not less than four months at the Public Administration Training Centre, or at any other institute and in such subjects or fields as may be determined, from time to time, by the Government:

Provided that the Government may, by order, increase or decrease the period of foundational training under special circumstances; and"; and

- (iii) after sub-rule (2), the following new sub-rule shall be added, namely:—
 - "(3) This rule shall not apply in the case of a person initially appointed to a Service by promotion, who, on such appointment, attained the age of fifty years during the period of probation or within a period not exceeding one year after the expiry of the period of probation.";
- (c) after rule 7, the following new rule shall be inserted, namely:-
 - "7A. Execution of bond, etc.—(1) A person initially appointed to a Service by direct recruitment shall, before the commencement of his training, execute a bond with one surety to refund all moneys paid to him as salary or remuneration and also such amount, as the Government determines, spent in connection with his training, in the event of his resigning service during the period of probation or within three years thereafter.
 - (2) If any person absents himself from duty, without submitting resignation or before the acceptance of resignation or prior to

making refund of the money under sub-rule (1), he shall be deemed to have deserted the service and the moneys payable by him under sub-rule (1) shall be recovered from him under the provisions of the Public Demands Recovery Act, 1913 (Bengal Act No. III of 1913)."; and

(d) in rule 9, for the figure "1984" wherever occurring, the figure "1985" shall be substituted.
