

# GOVERNMENT OF THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF BANGLADESH MINISTRY OF ESTABLISHMENT

#### NOTIFICATION

### Dhaka, the 28th March, 1985

No. S.R.O. 150-L/85/MER(R-II) R-22/83-64.—In pursuance of the Proclamation of the 24th day of March, 1982 and in exercise of all powers enabling him in that behalf, the President is pleased to make the following further amendments in the Senior Services Pool Order, 1979, namely:—

In the aforesaid Order-

- (a) in paragraph 2, in sub-paragraph (4),-
  - (i) in clause (c), the word "and" at the end shall be omitted; and
  - (ii) after clause (d), the following new clauses shall be added, namely:-
    - "(e) two posts of Deputy Secretary and one post of Joint Secretary in the Election Commission Secretariat; and
    - (f) two posts of Deputy Secretary in the Parliament Secretariat.";
- (b) in paragraph 3, in sub-paragraph (3), in clause (c), for the full-stop at the end a semi-colon shall be substituted and thereafter the following new clause shall be added, namely:—
  - "(d) serving members of the Armed Forces who are graduates and have ten years of commissioned service at their credit.";

(c) in paragraph 9, in sub-paragraph (2), for the full-stop at the end a semi-colon shall be substituted and thereafter the following proviso shall be added, namely:—

"Provided that Government may, if it deems it expedient so to do, specify, by notification in the official Gazette, additional period within which option under this paragraph may also be exercised:

Provided further that the power to specify additional period under the first proviso may be exercised once.";

- (d) for paragraph 10, the following shall be substituted, namely :-
  - "10. Exception.—Notwithstanding anything contained in this Order, the President may appoint any person on contract or on secondment or on deputation to any post mentioned in paragraph 2:

Provided that appointment on contract, secondment or deputation shall not exceed ten per cent of the total number of sanctioned duty posts in any level:

Provided further that the officers appointed on contract or on secondment or on deputation against any pool post shall not be regular members of the pool."; and

(e) for the Schedule, the following shall be substituted, namely :-
