No. S.R.O. 152-L/84 LMVIII/5(4)/83.—Whereas the Government is of the opinion that all classes of employment under the Bangladesh Bank, Sonali Bank, Janata Bank, Agrani Bank, Pubali Bank, Rupali Bank, Uttara Bank Ltd., Bangladesh Krishi Bank, Bangladesh Shilpa Bank, Bangladesh Shilpa Rin Shangstha, Investment Corporation of Bangladesh and House Building Finance Corporation are essential for maintaining services necessary to the life of the Community;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 3 of the Essential Services (Second) Ordinance, 1958 (E.P. Ord. XLI of 1958), the Government is pleased to declare all classes of employment under the Bangladesh Bank, Sonali Bank, Janata Bank, Agrani Bank, Pubali Bank, Rupali Bank, Uttara Bank Ltd., Bangladesh Krishi Bank, Bangladesh Shilpa Bank, Bankladesh Shilpa Rin Sangstha, Investment Corporation of Bangladesh and Bangladesh House Building Finance Corporation to be classes of employment to which the said Ordinance applies.
