No. S.R.O. 170-L/84.—In pursuance of the Proclamation of the 24th March, 1982, and in exercise of all powers enabling him in that behalf, the President after consultation with the Bangladesh Public Service Commission, is pleased to make the following amendment in the Gazetted Posts (Taxes Department) Recruitment Rules, 1981, namely:—

In the aforesaid rules, in the Schedule, against Sl. No. 1-

- (a) in column 4, the words "Selection Grade" shall be omitted; and
- (b) in column 5, for the words "post of Selection Grade" the words "Selection Grade of the post of" shall be substituted.
- This amendment shall be deemed to have taken effect from the 18th August, 1981.

Case Nos. 65/84 and 66/84, failing which they will be tried in absentia and their properties, both movable and immovable, may be forfeited to the Government:
