NOTIFICATION

Dacca, the 27th May 1975.

No. S.R.O. 172-L/75.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 133 of the Constitution of the People's Republic of Bangladesh, the President, after consultation with the Bangladesh Public Service (First) Commission as required by clause (2) of Article 140 of that Constitution, is pleased to make the following rules, namely:—

- 1. Short title.—These rules may be called the Superintendent (Road Transport Maintenance) Recruitment Rules, 1975.
 - 2. Definitions.—In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires.—
 - (a) "appointing authority" means the Government and includes any officer authorised by Government to make appointment to the post;
 - (b) "Commission" means the Bangladesh Public Service (First) Commission;
 - (c) "post" means the post of the Superintendent of the Road Transport Maintenance;
 - (d) "recognised University" means a University established by or under any law for the time being in force and includes any other University declared by Government, after consultation with the Commission, to be a recognised University for the purpose of these rules; and
 - (e) "Schedule" means the Schedule of these rules.

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- 3. Procedure of recruitment.—(1) Subject to the provisions of the Schedule and such instructions relating to reservation for the purposes of clause (3) of Article 29 of the Constitution, appointment to the post shall be made by direct recruitment.
- (?) No person shall be appointed to the post unless he has the requisite qualifications, and he is within the age limit prescribed in the Schedule for the post.

Explanation. The "requisite qualification" means the qualification prescribed in the Schedule for the post.

- 4. Appointment.—(I) No appointment to the post shall be made except upon recommendation of the Commission.
 - (2) No person shall be eligible for appointment to the post if he-
 - (a) is not a citizen of Bangladesh,
 - (b) is married to, or has entered into a promise of marriage with, a person who is not a citizen of Bangladesh.
 - (3) No appointment to a post shall be made until-
 - (a) the person selected for appointment is certified by a Medical Board set up for the purpose by the Government to be medically fit for such appointment and that he does not suffer from any such organic defect as is likely to interfere with the discharge of the duties of the post;
 - (b) the antecedents of the person so selected have been verified through appropriate agencies and found to be such as do not render him unfit for appointment to Government service.
- 5. Probation.—(1) Person selected for appointment to the post against a substantive vacancy shall be appointed on probation for a period of two years from the date of substantive appointment.
- (2) Where, during the period of probation of the probationer, the appointing authority is of opinion that his conduct and work are unsatisfactory or that he is not likely to become efficient, it may, before the expiry of that period, terminate the service of the probationer.
 - (3) After completion of the period of probation the appointing authority-
 - (a) if it is satisfied that the conduct and the work of the probationer have been satisfactory, shall, subject to the provisions of sub-rule (4) confirm him; and
 - (b) if it is of opinion that the conduct and work of the probationer during that period were not satisfactory, may—
 - (i) terminate the service, or
 - (ti) extend the period of probation by a period or periods so that the extended period does not exceed two years in aggregate.

Explanation.—The period of probation of a probationer shall be deemed to have been extended until any order under this sub-rule has been made.

(4) A probationer shall not be confirmed in the post until he has passed such examination and training as the Government may, from time to time, direct.

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নং এস, আর, ও, ১৭৩-এল/৭৫-আরকর—আরকর আইন ১৯২২ (১৯২২-এর XI)-এর ধারা ১৫-ডির উপ-ধারা (৫)-এ প্রদত্ত ক্ষমতাবলে জাতীয় রাজস্ব বোর্ড ইমামিয়া এতিমখানা, গ্রাম শ্যামগঞ্জ, পোঃ পানপাড়া, খানা লক্ষীপরে, জিলা নোয়াখালী-কে উত্ত ধারায় বর্ণিত উন্দেশ্যের জন্য নিন্দে উল্লেখিত শর্তসাপেকে একটি প্রতিষ্ঠান হিসাবে অনুমোদন দান করিতেছেঃ

- (ক) প্রতি বংসর প্রতিষ্ঠানের হিসাব নোয়াখালীর সমাজ-কল্যাণ সংগঠক বা তাহার মনোনতি অফিসার দ্বারা প্রেভাবে নিরীক্ষা করিতে হইবে এবং উপ্ত নিরীক্ষাকৃত হিসাব সেই আয়কর অফিসারের নিকট দাখীল করিতে হইবে ঘাঁহার অধীনসহ এলাকার উক্ত প্রতিষ্ঠানের প্রধান কার্যালয় অবিস্থিত।
- (খ) বর্তমান প্রতিষ্ঠান অন্য কোনও দাতব্য প্রতিষ্ঠান বা তহবিলে কোনর প দান বা অর্থ-মঞ্জুরী করিবে না যে প্রতিষ্ঠান বা তহবিল আয়কর আইনের ধারা ১৫-ডির উপ-ধারা (৫)-এর অধীনে অন্মোদন প্রাণ্ড নহে, এবং
- (গ) যদি কখনও বর্তমান প্রতিষ্ঠানের বিল্পিত ঘটে তবে বিল্পিতর সময় সংস্থার ধার-দেনার চাইতে বেশী যদি কোনও সম্পত্তি বা সম্পদ থাকে, তাহা এমন কোনও প্রতিষ্ঠান বা তহবিলে হস্তান্তর করিতে হইবে যাহা ১৯২২ সালের আয়কর আইনের ধারা ১৫-ডির উপ-ধারা (৫)-এর অধীনে অনুমোদনপ্রাণ্ড।
