Dhaka, the 15th May 1984

No. S.R.O. 174-L/84.—In pursuance of the Proclamation of the 24th March, 1982, and in exercise of all powers enabling him in that behalf, the President, after consultation with the Bangladesh Public Service Commission, is pleased to make the following rules, namely:—

THE GAZETTED OFFICERS (INSTITUTE OF CARDIOVASCULAR DISEASES) RECRUITMENT RULES, 1984

1. **Short title.**—These rules may be called the Gazetted Officers (Institute of Cardiovascular Diseases) Recruitment Rules, 1984.

2. **Definitions.**—In these rules, unless there is anything repugnant in the subject or context,—

- (a) "appointing authority" means the Government and includes in relation to any specified post or class of specified posts, any officer authorised by the Government to make appointment to that post or class of posts;
- (b) "approved journal" means such journal as may be recognised by the Council;

- (c) "Commission" means the Bangladesh Public Service Commission;
- (d) "Council" means the Bangladesh Medical and Dental Council constituted under the Medical and Dental Council Act, 1980 (XVI of 1980);
- (e) "probationer" means a person appointed on probation to a specified post;
- (f) "recognised institute" means an institute recognised by the Council;
- (g) "requisite qualification" in relation to a specified post, means the qualification laid down in the Schedule in relation to that post;
- (h) "Schedule" means the Schedule annexed to these Rules;
- (i) "specified post" means a post specified in the Schedule; and
- (j) "teaching experience" means experience in teaching acquired in a Medical institute recognised by the Council.

3. **Procedure for recruitment.**—(1) Subject to the provisions of the Schedule, appointment to a specified post shall be made by direct recruitment.

(2) No person shall be appointed to a specified post unless he has the requisite qualification and he is also within the age limit laid down in the Schedule for that post:

Provided that in the case of persons already in the service of the Republic, the provision of age limit shall not be applicable.

4. **Appointment.**—(1) No appointment to a specified post shall be made except upon the recommendation of the Commission.

(2) No person shall be eligible for appointment to a specified post, if he—

- (a) is not a citizen of, or a permanent resident in, Bangladesh; or
- (b) is married to, or has entered into a promise of marriage with, a person who is not a citizen of Bangladesh.

(3) No appointment to a specified post shall be made until—

- (a) the person selected for appointment is certified by a Medical Board set up for the purpose by the Director General of Health Services to be medically fit for such appointment and that he does not suffer from any such organic defect as is likely to interfere with the discharge of the duties of the specified post; and
- (b) the antecedents of the persons so selected have been verified through appropriate agencies and found to be such as do not render him unfit for appointment in the service of the Republic.

(4) No person shall be recommended for appointment to a specified post unless—

- (a) he applied in such form, accompanied by such fee before such date as was notified by the Commission while inviting application for the specified post; and

- (b) in the case of a person already in the service of the Republic or in the service of a local authority, he applied through his official superior.

5. **Probation.**—(1) Persons selected for appointment to a specified post shall be appointed on probation for a period of two years from the date of substantive appointment:

Provided that the appointing authority may, for reasons to be recorded in writing, extend the period of probation by a period or periods so that the extended period does not exceed two years in aggregate.

(2) Where, during the period of probation of a probationer, the appointing authority is of opinion that the conduct and work of the probationer is not satisfactory or that he is not likely to become efficient, it may, before the expiry of that period, terminate his service;

(3) After the completion of the period of probation including the extended period, if any, the appointing authority—

- (a) if it is of opinion that the conduct and work of the probationer during his period of probation has been satisfactory shall, subject to sub-rule (4), confirm him, and
- (b) if it is of opinion that the conduct and work of the probationer during that period was not satisfactory, may terminate his service.

(4) A probationer shall not be confirmed in a specified post until he has passed such examination and has undergone such training as the Government may, from time to time, direct.

- (d) Experience in the speciality for 5 years ; and
- (e) Teaching experience for 5 years.

Preference will be given to candidates having publications of original papers in approved Journals.

- (a) M.B.B.S. or equivalent degree recognised by the Council ;
- (b) Post-graduate degree or diploma as may be recognised by the Council ;
- (c) Training in Cardiac Surgery for minimum 6 months in a recognised institute.
- (d) Experience in speciality for 7 years ; and
- (e) Teaching experience for 7 years.

Preference will be given to candidates having publication of original papers in approved Journals.
