

NOTIFICATION

Dhaka, the 26th May 1984

No S.R.O. 187-L/84—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 23 of the Bangladesh Standards Institution Ordinance, 1977 (XXXIX of 1977), the Government, after consultation with the Bangladesh Standards Institutions,—

- (a) is pleased to prohibit, with effect from 1st December 1984, the sale and distribution of the articles specified in column 2 of the Schedule below, unless they conform to the Bangladesh Standards specified in column 3 thereof; and
- (b) is pleased to require that any article specified in the said Schedule which conforms to a particular Bangladesh Standard shall be marked with the Standard Mark.
