

  - (ii) to examine all proposals for promotions and initial appointments to the posts of Joint Secretary and above and Heads of Departments/Autonomous Bodies/Corporations duly processed through the Superior Selection Board and to make recommendations to the President; and
  - (iii) to examine any other matter which the President deems fit to refer to the Council Committee for consideration.

ML Case No. Co(A)77 arising out of Dhanmondi P.S. Case No. 53(8) 76.

#### PROCLAMATION

Whereas it appears that accused Mr Emdad Hossain Khandkar, ex-Manager, Pubali Bank, Science Laboratory Road Branch, Dacca, s/o. late Abdul Aziz Khandkar of 26/A, Cantonment Market Area, Dacca, is required for the purpose of trial under Regulation 3(7) of the Martial Law Regulation No. I of 1975 in the Special Martial Law Court No. I, Ganabhaban, Dacca;

And whereas this Court has reason to believe that the said accused Mr. Emdad Hossain Khandkar is absconding or concealing himself to avoid appearance or arrest for the said purpose;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Regulation 3(7) of the Martial Law Regulation No. I of 1975, this Special Martial Law Court No. I, Ganabhaban, Dacca, do hereby direct—

That the above accused person do appear in the Court on 4th August 1978, failing which he will be tried in absentia in Martial Law Case No. 96(A) 77 and his properties may be confiscated to the Government.
