PROCLAMATION

Martial Law Case No. 5/MLC/Spl. 8/84 arising out of Kalapara  
(Patuakhali) P.S. Case No. 6, dated 30th May 1983.

Whereas it has been made to appear to me that the accused persons specified in the schedule below, hereinafter referred to as the said accused persons, are required for the purpose of trial in Special Martial Law Court No. 8, Jessore;

And whereas the Court has reason to believe that the said accused person are absconding or concealing themselves to avoid appearance or arrest for the said purpose;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Regulation 2(11) of Martial Law Regulation No. I of 1982, this Special Martial Law Court No. 8, Jessore, do hereby direct the said accused persons to appear in this court at 10:00 a.m. on 16th June 1984 in M.L. Case No. 5/84, failing which they will be tried *in absentia* and their properties, both movable and immovable, may be forfeited to the Government:
