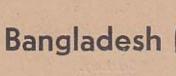

#### NOTIFICATION

Dacca, the 13th July, 1978.

No. S.R.O.198-L/78/433/D/Cus.—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 19 of the Customs Act, 1969 (IV of 1969), and section 7 of the Sales Tax Act, 1951 (III of 1951), the Government is pleased to exempt the goods specified in column (2) of the Table below and falling under the Heading Nos. of the First Schedule to the Tariff Act, 1934 (XXXII of 1934), as specified in column (1) of the said Table from the whole of the customs-duties and sales tax leviable thereon if they are imported between the 3rd August, 1978 and the 3rd September, 1978 (both days inclusive):

#### NOTIFICATION

#### Dacca, the 8th July, 1978.

No. S.R.O. 199-L/78-1(2)NIW(AI)/77/53.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 133 of the Constitution of the People's Republic of Bangladesh, the President, after consultation with the Bangladesh Public Service Commission as required by clause (2) of Article 140 of that Constitution, is pleased to make the following rules, namely:—

## THE GAZETTED TECHNICAL OFFICERS (MINISTRY OF INDUSTRIES) RECRUITMENT RULES, 1978.

- 1. Short title and commencement.—(1) These rules may be called the Gazetted Technical Officers (Ministry of Industries) Recruitment Rules, 1978.
  - (2) They shall come into force at once.
- 2. Definitions.—In these rules, unless there is anything repugnant in the subject or context,—
  - (a) "appointing authority" means the Government and includes, in relation to any specified post or class of such posts, any officer authorised by the Government to make appointment to such post or class of posts;
  - (b) "Commission" means the Bangladesh Public Service Commission;
  - (c) "probationer" means a person appointed on probation to a specified post;
- (d) "recognised university" means a university established by or under any law for the time being in force and includes any other university declared by the Government, after consultation with the Commission, to be a recognised university for the purposes of these rules;
  - (e) "requisite qualification", in relation to a specified post, means the qualification laid down in the Schedule in relation to that post;
  - (f) "Schedule" means the Schedule annexed to these rules; and
  - (g) "specified post" means a post specified in the Schedule.

- 3. Procedure for recruitment.—(1) Subject to the provisions of the Schedule and instructions relating to reservation for the purpose of clause (3) of Article 29 of the Constitution of the People's Republic of Bangladesh, appointment to a specified post shall be made—
  - (a) by direct recruitment; or
  - (b) by promotion; or
  - (c) by transfer on deputation.
- (2) No person shall be appointed to a specified post unless he has the requisite qualification and, in the case of direct recruitment, he is also within the age limit laid down in the Schedule for that post:

Provided that the upper limit of age may be relaxed by five years in the case of freedom fighters.

- 4. Appointment by direct recruitment.—(1) No appointment to a specified post by direct recruitment shall be made except upon the recommendation of the Commission.
- (2) No person shall be eligible for appointment to a specified post by direct recruitment, if he—
  - (a) is not a citizen of Bangladesh; or a permanent resident of, or domiciled in, Bangladesh;
  - (b) is married to, or has entered into a promise of marriage with, a person who is not a citizen of Bangladesh.
- (3) No appointment to a specified post by direct recruitment shall be made
  - (a) the person selected for appointment is certified by a Medical Board set up for the purpose by the Director of Health Services to be medically fit for such appointment and that he does not suffer from any such organic defect as is likely to interfere with the discharge of the duties of the specified post; and
  - (b) the antecedents of the person so selected have been verified through appropriate agencies and found to be such as do not render him unfit for appointment in the service of the Republic.
- (4) No person shall be recommended for appointment to a specified post unless—
  - (a) he applied in such form, accompanied by such fee and before such date, as was notified by the Commission while inviting applications for the specified post; and
  - (b) in the case of a person already in the service of the Republic or in the service of a local authority, he applied through his official superior.

- 5. Appointment by promotion or transfer.—(1) Appointment by promotion or by transfer shall be made after considering the recommendation of such Departmental Promotion Committee as the Government may constitute in this benalf.
- (2) A person shall not be eligible for appointment by promotion to a specified post if he has unsatisfactory records of service.
- 6. Probation.—(1) Persons selected for appointment to a specified post, otherwise than by transfer on deputation, against a substantive vacancy shall be appointed on probation,—
  - (a) in the case of direct recruitment, for a period of two years from the date of substantive appointment; and
  - (b) in the case of promotion, for a period of one year from the date of such appointment:
  - Provided that the appointing authority may, for reasons to be recorded in writing, extend the period of probation of any person by a period or periods so that the extended period does not exceed two years in the aggregate.
- (2) Soon after the completion of the period of probation including the extended period, if any, the appointing authority,—
  - (a) if it is satisfied that the conduct and work of the probationer during the period of his probation has been satisfactory, shall confirm him; and
  - (b) if it is of opinion that the conduct and work of the probationer during that period was not satisfactory, may,—
    - (i) in the case of direct recruitment, terminate his service; and
    - (ii) in the case of promotion, revert him to the post from which he was promoted.
