এস, আর, ও নং ২১২-আইন/৯৬—Police Act, 1861 (V of 1861) section 2 তে প্রদন্ত ক্ষমতাবলে সরকার Police Regulations Bengal, 1943 volume I এ নিন্দার প অধিকতর সংশোধন করিল, যথা :--

## উপরি-উক্ত Regulations এর\_

- (১) regulation 740 এর পর "Sub-Inspectors." শিরনামার নীচে "I-Unarmed Police" উপ-শিরনামার পরিবর্তে "I-Unarmed Police (other than Special Branch)" উপ-শিরনামা প্রতিস্থাপিত হইবে।;
- (2) regulation 741 of
  - (ক) clause (b) এর
    - (অ) প্রথম paragraph এর "Vacancies shall be filled once yearly, fifty percent by direct recruitment and fifty percent by promotion from the rank of Assistant Sub-Inspector" শব্দসালৈ ও ক্যাটির পরিবর্তে "vacancies in the units other than those in the Special Branch shall be filled once yearly,

- (খ) clause (d) এর sub-clause (ii) এর "and the Intelligence Branch" শব্দগর্ল এবং "and Intelligence Branch Special Superintendent, Intelligence Branch" শব্দগর্লি ও ক্যাগর্ল বিল্কত ইইবে;
- (গ) clause (g) এর পরিবতে নিন্নর্প clause (g) প্রতিস্থাপিত হইবে বথা :--
  - "(g) Qualifications:—The qualifications of a candidate for direct recruitment shall be as follows:—
    - (i) must have at least a Bachelor's degree from a University recognised by the Government;
    - (ii) must be of good moral character;
    - (iii) must be a citizen of Bangladesh and a permanent resident of the district from where the candidate applies;
    - (iv) must be unmarried and shall remain so until completion of his or her probation period;
    - (v) must be free from any linguistic or organic defect as is likely to interfere with the discharge of duties of the specific post; Explanation:—Stuttering or stammering is a defelt which renders an applicant ineligible;
    - (vi) must be free from disease, constitutional affection or such physical or mental infirmity which renders or is likely to render an applicant unfit in performing his of her duties;
    - (vii) must be in the case of a male candidate, not less than 1.63 metre in weight and 76 centimetre on normal and 81 centimetre on expansion in chest measurement with an approved standard body weight, and in the case of a female candidate, not less than 1.58 metre in height with any measurement of chest and body-weight;

(viii) must know swimming and cycling;

- (ix) The Inspector-General of Police may, with the prior approval of the Government, relax the above qualifications in case of candidates belonging to tribal communities and in special cases".;

## "IA-Unarmed Police (Special Branch)

- (a) Appointing Authority: —Special Superintendent of Police (Administration), Special Branch Dhaka/Vice-Principal, Police Academy, Sardah.
- (b) Method of recruitment:—(i) Vacancies in the Special Branch shall be filled in once a year, 50% by direct recruitment and 50% by promotion from the rank of Assistant Sub-Inspector of Special Branch and other units of the Unarmed Police.
- (ii) In August each year the Inspector-General shall collect from the Additional Inspector-General, Special Branch, the total number of permanent vacancies which have occurred or are due to occur upto the 31st December of the year.
- (iii) The posts to be filled in by direct recruitment shall be distributed by the Inspector-General amongst the district on population basis and also in consideration of the other criteria of quota as may be fixed by the Government from time to time.
- (c) Direct recruitment:—(i) Advertisement for such recruitment shall be made by the Police Headquarters through leading daily newspapers. Applications for the post shall be received by the Additional Inspector-General of Police, Special Branch, Dhaka.
- (ii) The Additional Inspector-General of Police, Special Branch, will arrange to take the physical measurement and physical test, written examination and psychological test of the applicants on date or dates mentioned in the advertisement.
- (iii) Only those candidates who will be found suitable in the physical test will be called to sit for the written examination.
- (iv) Police Headquarters will arrange setting of question papers for written examination by Police officers not below the rank of Superintendent of Police to be Selected by the Inspector-General

of Police. The candidates shall have to sit for the following examinations and tests of 300 marks:

The answer scripts shall be sent in sealed covers to the examiners to be selected by the Inspector-General of Police. The examiners so selected shall be officers not below the rank of Superintendent of Police. After examining the answer scripts the examiners shall send the mark sheet together with the answer scripts in sealed covers to the Deputy Inspector-General of Police, Special Branch. within a time prescribed therefor.

- (v) The candidates who secure 50% marks or above in each subject shall be called for viva-voce test by the Selection Board constituted under clause (vi). The minimum pass marks in the viva-voce test is 25 (that is, 50% of the total marks allotted for it).
- (vi) The Selection Board shall consist of the Deputy Inspector-General of Police of Special Branch as chairman and three other members, namely, Special Superintendent of Police (Admisistration), Special Branch, one Assistant Inspector-General of Police designated for the purpose by the Inspector-General of Police, and the Superintendent, District Special Branch, Dhaka.
- (vii) The Selection Board shall, after taking viva-voce test, prepare a list of qualified candidates and send the same to the Assistant Inspector-General of Police, Police Headquarters, designated for the purpose, who shall cause verification of the character and antecedents of the selected candidates through respective Superintendents, District Special Branches.
- (viii) The said Assistant Inspector-General of Police shall also direct the qualified candidates to report to the Superintendent, Police Hospital, Dhaka, for their medical examination. The Superintendent, Police Hospital, Dhaka, shall examine the candidates medically and submit certificates of fitness or otherwise to the said Assistant Inspector-General.

- (d) Qualifications:—The qualifications of a candidate for direct recruitment shall be as follows:—
  - (i) must have at least a Bachelor's degree from a university recognised by Government with at least one First Division and one Second Division or Class in the public examinations he appeared, preference will be given to the candidates having a Second Class Master's Degree;
  - (ii) must be of good moral character;
  - (iii) must be a citizen of Bangladesh and a permanent resident of the District from where the candidated applies;
  - (iv) must be unmarried and shall remain so until completion of his or her probation period;
  - (v) must be free from any linguistic or organic defect as is likely to interfere with the discharge of duties of the specific post; Explanation:—Stuttering or stammering is a defect which

renders an applicant ineligible;

- (vi) must be free from disease, constitutional affection or such physical or mental infirmity which renders or is likely to render an applicant unfit in performing his or her duties;
- (vii) must be in the case of a male candidate, not less than 1.63 metre in height and 76 centimetre on normal and 81 centimere on expansion in chest measurement with an approved standard body-weight and in the case of a female candidate, not less than 1.58 metre in height with any measurement of chest and body-weight;
- (viii) must know swimming and cycling;
  - (ix) the Inspector-General of Police may, with the prior approval of the Government, relax the above qualifications in case of candidates belonging to tribal communities and in special cases;
- (e) Age limit for direct recruitment.—A candidate shall not be below 19 years and over 27 years of age on the 1st September of the calender year in which recruitment is made.
- (f) Training.—The Principal, Police Academy, Sardah, shall arrange the training of the cadet Sub-Inspectors for six months. After successful completion of the training at police Academy, Sardah, the cadet Sub-Inspectors will join Special Branch Training school, Dhaka, for undergoing training for another six months. The

Commandant, Special Branch Training school, shall arrange this training. During the respective training period, the Vice-Principal, Police Academy, Sardah, or as the case may be, the Commandant, Special Branch Training school, may terminate the service of a cadet Sub-Inspector, if, in his opinion,—

- (i) the cadet is not properly undertaking the training or has failed to successfully undertake the training; or
- (ii) the conduct of the cadet is not satisfactory. In so terminating the service of a cadet Sub-Inspector, the Vice-Principal of the Commandant, as the case may be, need not give the cadet any opportunity of showing cause.
- (g) Promotion of Assistant Sub-Inspectors.—(i) For promiting the Assistant Sub-Inspectors of the Special Branch, there shall be a selection Board consisting of the following three members, namely:—

Deputy Inspector-General of Police, Special Branch. Who shall be the Chairman of of the Board.

Special Superintendent of police (Administration), Special Branch.

Member.

Assistant Inspector-General of police designated by the police Headquarters.

Member.

- (ii) The Board shall prepare a list of Assistant Sub-Inspectors of the Special Branch whom it considers fit for promotion and shall forward the list to the appointing authority who shall promote the enlisted persons to the post of Sub-Inspector.
- (iii) In selecting the Assistant Sub-Inspectors for promotion, the Board shall, as far as possible, follow the provisions of Sub-clauses (iii) to (v) of clause (d) of this regulation under the heading I.—Unarmed Police (other than Special Branch).
- (h) Special Provisions for direct recruits.—The officers who are directly recruited as Sub-Inspector of Police of the Special Branch shall not be transferred from the Special Branch including its City Railway and District offices to any Branch or unit under the Police Headquarters or any other agency till their promotion to the next higher post.";

  - "(g) Qualifications.—The qualifications of a candidate for direct recruitment as Constable shall be as follows:—
    - (i) must have passed at least Secondary School Certificate examination or an equivalent examination from a Board recognised by the Government;
    - (ii) must be a citizen of Bangladesh and a permanent resident of the district from where the candidate applies for recruitment;
    - (iii) must be unmarried;
    - (iv) must be in the case of a male candidate, not less than 1.68 metre in height and 79 centimetre on normal and 84 centimetre on expansion in chest measurement with an weight of approved standard and in the case of a female candidate, not less than 1.58 metre in height with any measurement of chest and body-weight;
    - (v) must know swimming and cycling;
    - (vi) The Inspector-General of Police will have, the power to condone excess over the age limit and deficiency in respect of height, chest measurement and weight in extraordinary cases."
