Whereas, it appears to me that Pakhia, son of late Zari Khan of Madhaya Chaprai, P. S. Dimla, district Rangpur, is wanted in connection with Martial Law Special Case No. 106/77 [Dimla] P.S. Case No. 9 (10)69, u/s 366/376, B.P.C. (G.R. 690/69)];

And whereas I have reason to believe that the said accused person is absconding and is concealing himself so that he cannot be arrested and produced before this Court for trial;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in me under Regulation 3(7) of M.L.R. 1/75, I, Quazi Bashir Uddin, Chairman, Special Martial Law Court No.V, Rangpur, do hereby direct the aforesaid accused person to appear before me in my Court within 7(seven) days from the date of its publication.

It is further ordered that if the said accused person fails to comply with the above direction, he would be tried in his absence and his properties would be liable to be forfeited to the Government.
