

## ORDER

S. R. O. No. 235-L/81/2C-S-1/81-DI, dated the 8th July 1981

THE CHIEFS OF STAFF OF THE DEFENCE SERVICES (TENURE OF APPOINTMENT) ORDER, 1981

WHEREAS it is expedient to make provision for regulating the tenure of appointment of chiefs of staff of the defence services;

Now, Therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (2) of article 62 of the Constitution of the People's Republic of Bangladesh, the President is pleased to make the following Order, namely:—

- 1. Short title and commencement.—(1) This Order may be called the Chiefs of Staff of the Defence Services (Tenure of Appointment) Order, 1981.
  - (2) It shall come into force at once.
- 2. Tenure of appointment.—The tenure of appointment of a chief of staff of a defence service shall, unless the incumbent retires earlier or the President orders him to retire earlier in the public interest, be four years with effect from the date of his appointment:

Provided that the President may, if he considers it expedient in the public interest, by order, extend this period by one year.
