- (f) the Consultative Committee shall meet at such place and in such time as the Government may decide in this behalf; and
- (g) the Consultative Committee shall perform the following functions, namely:—
  - to aid, assist and advise the Government in formulating a constructive labour policy for the country taking into account the suggestions made by the organisations of workers and employers;
  - (ii) to advise the Government regarding various steps and measures that may be taken on labour matters for promotion of harmony and good relations between workers and employers, taking into account the over all socio-economic goals of the Government and existing resources of the country;
  - (iii) to assist and advise the Government on any matter referred to it for advice taking into account the suggestions made by the organisations of workers and employers;

- (iv) to apprise the Government generally on matters relating to labour problems facing the country; and
- (v) to advise the Government as to how to make the best possible use of existing resources to increase productivity.
