- (c) in the absence of the Chairman,  of Labour and Industrial Welfare shall be the Chairman of the Consultative Committee;
- (d) the Member-Secretary may, in the absence of the Chairman or in his absence, the Secretary, Ministry of Labour and Industrial Welfare, invite any person who is conversant with Labour problems with the  and conversant with Labour problems with the  Committee is confronted with, to attend any or all of the meetings of the  and also to participate in the discussion of the 
- (e) the Consultative Committee shall ordinarily meet twice a year but the Chairman may call special or emergent meeting as and when he considers it necessary;
- (f) the Consultative Committee shall meet at such place and in such time as the Government may decide in this behalf; and
- (g) the Consultative Committee shall perform the following functions, namely :—
- (i) to aid, assist and advise the Government in formulating a constructive labour policy for the country taking into account the suggestions made by the organisations of workers and employers;
  - (ii) to advise the Government regarding various steps and measures that may be taken on labour matters for promotion of harmony and good relations between workers and employers, taking into account the over all socio-economic goals of the Government and existing resources of the country;
  - (iii) to assist and advise the Government on any matter referred to it for advice taking into account the suggestions made by the organisations of workers and employers;

- (iv) to apprise the Government generally on matters relating to labour problems facing the country; and
- (v) to advise the Government as to how to make the best possible use of existing resources to increase productivity.

The erstwhile Ministry of Health, Population Control and Labour (Labour and Social Welfare Division) Notification No. S-VII/18(16)/76/71, dated the 3rd February, 1976, is hereby superseded.

PROCLAMATION

Whereas I have been informed by the Magistrate, Karikar, village Mukundapur, P. S. Satkhira, that the accused person named Abu Zafar Karikar, village Mukundapur, P. S. Satkhira, has failed to appear to me for the purpose of trial in the Summary Martial Law Regulation 19 MLR in connection with Tala P. S. Case No. 6, dated the 27th March 1978.

And whereas I have no reason to believe that the said accused person is at present in the country and is endeavouring to avoid appearance and arrest for the said purpose.

Now, therefore, the said accused person is directed to appear in this Court on 28th September 1978, failing which he will be tried *in absentia* and his properties may be forfeited to the State.
