No. S.R.O. 266-L/85/S-IX/SE-1/85.—In exercise of the power conferred by sub-section (1) of section 3 of Shops and Establishments Act, 1965 (E. P. Act VII of 1965), the Government is pleased to suspend the operation of clause (a) of section 10 of the said Act in respect of those commercial establishments who are members of the Metropolitan Chamber of Commerce and Industries, Dhaka and the Bangladesh Employers' Association and where five and a half working days in a week are observed for the month of Ramazan in 1985, subject to the following conditions, namely:—

- (a) every such worker shall be allowed an interval of at least half an hour during the first five working days of the week for rest or recess; and
- (b) the normal weekly working hours shall be reduced by at least two and a half hours.
