Dacca, the 25th September, 1979.

No. S.R.O. 267-L/79/18-Excise.—In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 12A of the Excises and Salt Act, 1944 (I of 1944), the Government is pleased to make the following further amendment in this Ministry's Notification No. S. R. O. 7 (D)/EXC/72, dated the 30th June, 1972, namely:—

In the aforesaid Notification, in the TABLE, in serial No. 40 in column 1 for entry (ee) in column 2 and the entries relating thereto in columns 3 and 4 the following shall be substit ted, namely:—

"(ee) Gold and silver or products thereof dealt in with, 48(1) and (2) Nil" or disposed of to, a customer by a person working and transacting business in his home without any assistance of any employee or through any subcontract with any other person but with the assistance of his wife or sons or unmarried daughters:

Provided that-

(i) the total weight of gold and products thereof dealt in or transacted as aforesaid does not

exceed fifty tolas, or of silver and products thereof does not exceed two hundred tolas, or in case the person deals in or disposes of both gold and silver and products thereof, the total value of the same does not exceed taka one lakh, in any financial year;

- (ii) the quality or workmanship of the goods is not advertised in any manner; and
- (iii) the business or any transactions relating thereto with any customer is not carried on in the areas under the Dacca Improvement Trust, the Chittagong Development Authority, the Khulna Development Authority, any municipality and such other areas as may be specified by the Board in this behalf from time to time."

No. S.R.O. 268-L/79.—In exercise of powers conferred by section 78 of the Registration Act, 1908 (XVI of 1908), the Government is pleased to make the following further amendment in the Table of fees published under the Ministry of Land Administration and Land Reforms Notification No. S.R.O. 12-L/74/RE-169/74/219-Rstn, dated the 29th June, 1974:—

In the aforesaid Table, under the heading "1. Ordinary Fees", in paragraph A, in sub-paragraph (2), in the proviso, after clause (e), the following new clause (f) shall be added, namely:—

"(f) If a lease is executed in duplicate and both the principal and duplicate are presented for registration at the same time, the fee payable for the registration of the principal shall be equal to that payable for the registration of the lease and the fee payable for registration of the duplicate shall be Tk. 3.".
