## PUBLIC NOTICE No. 50(80)/IMPORT

## Dacca, the 27th August 1980

It is hereby notified for the information of the concerned exporters of readymade garments that export performance licence @ 40% on the net value added to the foreign exchange shall be issued against export of readymade garments to the following 3 (three) categories:

- (a) The garments exported are manufactured with fabrics produced locally:
- (b) The garments exported are manufactured with imported fabrics; and
- (c) The garments exported are manufactured by fabrics supplied by the importers without involving payment in foreign exchange and the exporters charged only the manufacturing cost of the garments.
- 2. The concerned exporters are advised to apr ly for XPL with required documents to the Chief Controller of Imports & Exports, Dacca through the Director, Textiles, 30, Mirpur Road, Dacca.
