#### Section I

#### NOTIFICATION

#### Dacca, the 5th October, 1979.

No. S.R.O. 285-L 79/P(Sec-1)2E-48/79-686.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 133 of the Constitution of the People's Republic of Bangladesh, the President, after consultation with the Bangladesh Public Service Commission as required by clause (2) of article 140 of that Constitution, is pleased to make the following rules, namely:—

### SECTION OFFICERS (BANGLADESH POST OFFICE) RECRUITMENT RULES, 1979.

- 1. Short title.—These rules may be called Section Officers (Bangladesh Post Office) Recruitment Rules, 1979.
- 2. Definitions.—In these rules, unless there is anything repugnant in the subject or context,—
  - (a) "appointing authority" means the Government and includes any officer authorised by the Government to make appointment to the specified post;
  - (b) "Commission" means the Bangladesh Public Service Commission;
  - (c) "Probationer" means a person appointed on probation to the specified post;
  - (d) "requisite qualification" in relation to the specified post means the qualification laid down in the Schedule;
  - (e) "specified Post" means the post specified in the Schedule; and
  - (f) "Schedule" means the Schedule annexed to these rules.

- 3. Procedure for recruitment.—(1) Subject to the provisions of the Schedule and instructions relating to reservation for the purpose of clause (3) of article 29 of the Constitution of the People's Republic of Bangladesh, appointment to the specified post shall be made—
  - (a) by promotion; or
  - (b) by transfer.
- (2) No person shall be appointed to the specified post unless he has the requisite qualification laid down in the schedule.
- 4. Appointment.—No appointment to the specified post shall be made except upon the recommendation of the Commission and in the case of a person for promotion, he has satisfactory records of service.
- 5. Probation.—(1) Persons selected for appointment by promotion to the specified post against a substantive vacancy shall be appointed on probation for a period of one year from the date of such appointment:

Provided that the appointing authority may for reasons to be recorded in writing extend the period of probation by a period or periods so that the extended period does not exceed two years in the aggregate.

- (2) Where during the period of probation of a probationer the appointing authority is of opinion that his conduct and work is unsatisfactory or that he is not likely to become efficient, it may, before the expiry of that period revert him to the post from which he was promoted.
- (3) After the completion of the period of probation including the extended period, if any, the appointing authority—
  - (a) if it is satisfied that the conduct and work of the probationer during the period of probation has been satisfactory, shall, subject to the provision of sub-rule (4), confirm him; and
  - (b) if it is of opinion that the conduct and work of the probationer during that period was not satisfactory, may revert him to the post from which he was promoted.
- (4) A probationer shall not be confirmed in the specified post until he has passed such examination and undergone such training as the Government may, from time to time, direct.

The following amendments in the Import Policy Order, 1979-80 are notified for the information of all concerned:

1. In Annex 1 (Priority List 1), after Sl. No. 188, the following shall be inserted:

"188A. Train light equipments"

- (b) against Sl. No. 97 (Radio assembly—A. Radio), the following shall be inserted under column 4 (Remark), against raw material item No. 1 of column 31
  - "Components and radio-kit in CKD condition shall also be permissible for import as raw materials".
- (c) against Sl. No. 113 (Television sets), the following shall be inserted under column 4 (Remark), against raw material item No. 1 of column 3:
  - "Components/kit of television receiver shall also be permissible for import in CKD condition as raw materials".
- (d) against Sl. No. 17 (Bicycle and bicycle parts), the following shall be inserted under column 4, against the raw material item "Cycle parts" (Page 2645):
  - "Cycle parts include all items excluding locally manufactured parts, such as, Frame, Chain stay and back stay, Fork, Mudgu ard, Spc kes Handle bar, Brake, Pedal, Chain cover, Saddle, Bells, Carrier, Sandtand".
- 4. In Annex 4, the words "Director General of Industries" shown in the 3rd and 4th line of para 21 shall read as "Director of Textile".
- 5. In Annex 4, sub-para (vii) of para 29, the following industry shall be inserted after Sl. No. 124:
  - "124A. Train light equipments".
  - 6. In Annex 24, the following shall be inserted after the existing Sl. No. 26:
    - "27. Base paper for sand paper for Abrassive Industry".
