NOTIFICATION

Dacca, the 31st October, 1978.

No. S.R.O. 289-L/78/IE-50/77.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 133 of the Constitution of the People's Republic of Bangladesh, the President, after consultation with the Bangladesh Public Service Commission as required by clause (2) of article 140 of that Constitution is pleased to make the following rules, namely:-

THE SENIOR TRANSPORT ECONOMIST AND STATIS-TICIAN (TRANSPORT PLANNING GROUP) RECRUITMENT RULES, 1978.

1. Short title.—These rules may be called the Senior Transport Economist and Statistician (Transport Planning Group) Recruitment Rules, 1978.

2. Definitions.-In these rules, unless there is anything repugnant in the subject or context,

- (a) "appointing authority" means the Government and includes in relation to any specified post or class of such posts, any officer authorised by the Government to make appointment to such post or class of posts;
- (b) "Commission" means the Bangladesh Public Service Commission;
- (e) "recognised university" means a university established by or under any law for the time being in force and includes any other university declared by the Government, after consultation with the Commission, to be a recognised university for the purpose of these rules;
- (d) "requisite qualification", in relation to a specified post, means the qualification laid down in the Schedule in relation to that post;
- (e) "Schedule" means the Schedule annexed to these rules;

(f) "specified post" means a post specified in the Schedule.

3. Procedure for recruitment. -(1) Subject to the provisions of the Schedule and instructions relating to reservation for the purposes of clause (3) of article 29 of the Constitution of the People's Republic of Bangladesh, appointment to a specified post shall be made,

- (a) by direct recruitment; or
- (b) by promotion.

(2) No person shall be appointed to a specified post unless he has the requisite qualification and, in the case of direct recruitment, he is also within the age limit laid down in the Schedule for that post.

4. Appointment by direct recruitment.—(1) No appointment to a specified post by direct recruitment shall be made except upon the recommendation of the Commission.

(2) No person shall be eligible for appointment to a specified post by direct recruitment, if he-

- (a) is not a citizen of Bangladesh, or a permanent resident of, or domiciled in, Bangladesh;
- (b) is married to, or has entered into a promise of marriage with, a person who is not a citizen of Bangladesh.

(3) No appointment to a specified post by direct recruitment shall be made until—

- (a) the person selected for appointment is certified by a Medical Board set up for the purpose by the Government to be medically fit for such, appointment and that he does not suffer from any such organic defect as is likely to interfere with the discharge of the duties of the specified post; and
- (b) the antecedents of the person so selected have been verified through appropriate agencies and found to be such as do not render him unfit for appointment in the service of the Republic.

5. Appointment by Promotion.—Appointment by promotion to a specified post shall be made on the recommendation of such Departmental Promotion Committee as the Government may constitute in this behalf.
