No. S.R.O. 305-L/86/1011/Cus.—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 219 of the Customs Act, 1969 (IV of 1969) read with item 17 of the Third Schedule thereof, the National Board of Revenue is pleased to make the following amendments in the Passengers (Non-tourists) Baggage (Import) Rules, 1986, namely :—

- (1) in rule 3,—
 - (a) in sub-rule (1),
 - (i) in item (XIV), for the comma and word “, and” a semi-colon shall be substituted;
 - (ii) in item (XV), for the full-stop at the end a semi-colon shall be substituted and thereafter the following new item shall be added, namely :—

“(XVI) one portable typewriter in use (for working journalists only).”;
 - (b) in sub-rule (2), after the word and comma “sourvenirs,” the words, figure and comma “other than those specified in rule 4,” shall be inserted;
- (2) in rule 4(2), in the LIST,
 - (i) against items 2 and 3 in the first column, in the third column, for the present entries, the figure and words “50% *ad val*” shall be substituted;
 - (ii) against item 24 in the first column, in the third column, for the figure and word “6,000.00 taka” the figure and word “5,000.00 taka” shall be substituted.
