NOTIFICATION

Dacca, the 24th October, 1977.

No. S.R.O. 320-L/77.—Whereas certain incidents involving the Armed Forces took place at Bogra Cantonment on the night between 29th and 30th September, 1977 and at Dacca Cantonment on the night between 1st October and 2nd October, 1977;

And whereas these incidents are sufficiently grave and are of public importance, and the Government is of opinion that it is necessary to appoint a Commission of Inquiry for the purpose of making an enquiry into the said incidents;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 3 of the Commission of Inquiry Act, 1956 (VI of 1956), the Government is pleased to appoint a Commission of Inquiry consisting of the following Members, namely:

- (1) Mr Justice A. F. M. Ahsanuddin Chowdhury—*President*.
- (2) Mr Justice A. T. M. Masud—*Member*.

The Commission shall submit its report to the Government as soon as possible and the report shall—

- (a) contain in detail the extent of involvement of the Armed Forces and/or of any other person or group or body of persons;

- (b) state the extent of responsibility for the said incidents of any person or group or body of persons; and
- (c) state any other matter connected with the said incidents.
