

- (b) Sub-rule (11) shall be added, namely :-

Allotment of Government accommodation may be transferred to the father/son/unmarried daughter/husband/wife only of the allottee, if he/she is eligible for the same or for a higher class of accommodation in the event of death/retirement only or becomes entitled to such category of accommodation within 1 (one) year in the event of death and within 2 (two) months in the event of the retirement respectively. This facility will be admissible only in case the beneficiary has been ordinarily residing with the original allottee. In case he/she is entitled to a lower class of accommodation he/she shall be allotted the first available quarter in that class. Till an alternative accommodation is made available he/she may retain the accommodation in his/her occupation on payment of 7½%/5% of the minimum qualifying emoluments fixed for entitlement of the category of accommodation he/she is actually occupying.
