NOTIFICATION

Dhaka, the 11th July, 1984.

No. S.R.O. 334-L/84/S-XI/3R-10/84/355.—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 146 of the Paurashava Ordinance, 1977 (XXVI of 1977), the Government is pleased to make the following further amendment in the Municipal Committee (Taxation) Rules, 1960, namely:—

In the aforesaid Rules, for rule 8, the following shall be substituted, namely:-

- "8. Petition against valuation, assessment, etc.—(1) Any person who has been assessed to a tax, rate, toll or fee under the Ordinance may object to the valuation or assessment thereof, or his liability to be so taxed, by a petition presented to the Paurashava within fourteen days from the date of publication of notice of such assessment.
- (2) The petition shall state clearly the grounds of objection to the valuation or assessment or to the liability of the petitioner.

- (3) The Paurashava after due consideration of the petition may cancel or modify the valuation or assessment or pass such order as it deems fit.
- (4) Any person aggrieved by an order of the Paurashava may, within two months of the receipt of the order, prefer an appeal to such authority as the Government may direct in this behalf; and the decision of such authority, on such appeal, shall be final."
