No. S.R.O. 340-L/81/668/Cus.—In exercise of the powers conferred by clause, (c) of section 21 of the Customs Act, 1969 (iv of 1969), the National Board of Revenue is pleased to authorise repayment of customs-duties paid in excess of 15% ad valorem on the importation of raw materials and components used in the manufacture of shallow tube-well engines, strainers and G.I. pipes, subject to the following conditions:—

- (i) the importers-cum-manufacturers shall, at the time of importation of the raw materials and components, declare that the raw materials and components have been imported for use in the manufacturing of shallow tube-well engines, strainers and G.I. pipes;
- (ii) the declaration referred to in para (i) shall be submitted to the Collector of Customs of competent jurisdiction;
- (iii) the importers-cum-manufactures shall claim from the Collector of Customs of competent jurisdiction refund of customs-duties on the imported raw materials and components, the claim being supported by certificate in FORM-I set out below issued by the Director-General.

- (iv) the importer shall, within 180 days of the date of clearance of raw materials and components, claim from the Collector of Customs refund of the customs-duties paid on the imported materials and components, the claim being supported by a certificate in the Form set out below issued by the Director-General, Deputy Director-General or the Director of Industries of the Department of Industries.
