By direct recruitment.	1st Class Master's degree or 2nd Class Master's degree with 2nd Class honours in Bio-Chemistry or Pharmaceutical Chemistry or Pharmacy or Organic Chemistry. or Veterinary Science (Pharmacology or Microbiology) or Applied Chemistry from a recognised University. OR Bachelor of Science from a recognised University with five years' experience as Inspector of Drugs in the Department.”
